



GOD FIRST CORPORATE FAST

July 22, 2026

This corporate fast is a call to consecration. We are putting “God First” in every aspect of our lives. This week we are coming together in prayer, discipline, and expectation as we seek God first for personal transformation and corporate advancement.

WHAT IS FASTING

Fasting is the intentional act of setting aside food and distractions to pursue God more deeply. It humbles our hearts, sharpens our spiritual sensitivity, and positions us to hear God with clarity.

Fasting is an act of surrender. We intentionally open ourselves for God to reveal, heal, and transform what is within us. Through fasting, we align our desires with His will, strengthen our faith, and deepen our relationship with Him.

HOW TO FAST

1. With Discretion

Our fast is not for public recognition but private devotion. We fast unto God and not unto people.

Matthew 6:16–18 (NLT)

“And when you fast, don’t make it obvious... But when you fast, comb your hair and wash your face. Then no one will notice that you are fasting, except your Father... And your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.”

2. With Faith

Fasting is not ritual. It is faith in action.

We fast believing that God responds to those who seek Him.



Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)

“Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.”

Social Media and Cell Phone Restrictions

During our corporate fast, we will intentionally limit social media and cell phone usage to reduce distractions and create space for God's voice. Social media and cell phone usage will be limited to no more than 20 minutes during our fast and used ONLY for business, pertinent ministry, and emergency family situations. We are on God's time. Let's keep Him first!
