

Modified Reopening Protocol for Church Attendees

Last Update: June 3, 2020

- All frequently touched surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized before and after services.
- Hand sanitizer is available in multiple locations for use by attendees.
- No food or drink of any kind will be provided and none is allowed in any church building.
- All attendees have been advised that face masks are required to enter the church.
- All attendees have been advised that seating is limited and will be assigned in order to comply with six-foot spacing requirements.
- Printed bulletins/notices are to be taken home by attendees; no paper will be collected following the conclusion of a service.
- A collection plate is available upon entering the church as collection plates will not be passed.
- Clergy, staff, and volunteers:
 - have been trained in cleaning and sanitizing procedures,
 - have been screened for potential health issues,
 - will wash and sanitize hands before entering the building,
 - will wear face masks, and
 - will maintain a six-foot distance from attendees not in their family unit.
- Clergy and lay ministers will wash hands prior to distribution of communion wafer.
