Question: Where did I notice God's nearness this past year? Where did I resist it?

## 🔁 1 Samuel 7:1-2 — The Ark is Back

- Notice: Something feels off no celebrating, no Yahweh worship They simply put the ark in storage!
- (7:2b) "turned back to" = lamented / mourned
  This was a long and painful process of returning to the LORD
  —20 years!
- Israel's hearts were *reluctant to give up* the ways of the world and simply be the Kingdom of God.

# ■ 1 Samuel 7:3-4 — Israel's process of coming back to the LORD

- (v3) "IF you are returning to the LORD..."
  That "If" carries a lot of weight—20 years of continued idol worship needs to stop
- (v3-4) "the foreign gods" didn't demand exclusive loyalty
  - Baal 
     thought to have the power over nature (rains) meant good crops
  - Ashtoreth 
     thought to have power over fertility and life
  - The Israelite's main sin was misdirected allegiance
    - Exodus 20:3, 5 "You shall have no other gods before me..."
- (v4) Giving up their idol worship was their spiritual act of surrender
  - —this was all they knew! They'd been worshiping idols since Judges 10
  - —idol worship fostered their resistance to God's nearness.
  - -Samuel's words invite us to reflect on our own lives

# Israel's Repentance — God's Love — Our Response

- God's love made repentance possible (not the other way around)
  - o Romans 2:4b God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance.
- God's patience made room for repentance to finally take root in Israel's heart

#### God's Love

- 1 Samuel 7 shows God's love in action
- Romans 2:4b tells us the purpose of that love
- Psalm 103 puts language to that love...

## Psalm 103 — God's patient, steadfast and enduring love

- (v8) compassionate, gracious, slow to anger, abounding in **love** (hesed)
  - God is patient with us even when we find ourselves resisting Him
- (v10) His patience and love is a gift not earned that's grace
- (v11) unfailing, unchanging, unearned, unmanipulatable, unequaled love
- (v12) despite our past sins or hesitations, the Lord's forgiveness stands
- (v17) His love enables us to press on even if we fail, His love doesn't

# MAIN IDEA — Hesitation toward the Lord is not the same as rejection, but it does reveal where trust needs to grow.

- When we hesitate to respond to God's nearness,
  - —we're choosing to *manage it*
  - —this is what Israel did for 20 years!
  - —Israel didn't fully trust for a long time, yet **God remained patient** out of love
- QUESTION: Where might God be gently revealing areas in my life where trust can grow?
- Advent Love is God staying near even when we hesitate, resist, or manage
  - -Advent reminds us that Jesus is not distant
  - —His love is patient enough to meet us right where we are
