Through their examples (both good and bad), we saw how great leaders are the people most likely to follow through, choose to love, choose integrity, and follow God's lead.

Discuss This: How can you be a great leader in the spaces God has given you to point others to Jesus?

## **Not Okay**

In this series from the Gospels, we saw how, when we're not okay, Jesus offers hope. We'll discover that when people reject us, Jesus never will. We'll see that when it's not easy to do what's right, it's still worth it. And we'll be reminded that when you feel worried, Jesus can be trusted.

Discuss This: How are you implementing our four practices (Bible reading, prayer and solitude, random acts of kindness, worship) in your day to day life?
