Memory Verse July

July Bible Stories

WEEK 1: God Made Light

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:1–5*

Story Summary: At the very beginning, there was nothing—only darkness. Then God spoke and said, "Let there be light!" and light appeared! He separated light from darkness and called it good. This first act of creation reminds us that God brings light into the world and into our lives. In the New Testament, Jesus is called the Light of the World—He helps us see what is good and true.

WEEK 2: God Made the Sky and Water

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:6–8*

Story Summary: God made a space between the waters and called it sky. He created clouds, air, rain, and oceans. The sky reminds us of God's greatness, and the water reminds us of how God provides for all living things. Jesus calmed storms and walked on water—He is Lord over all creation and can bring peace in our lives too.

WEEK 3: God Made Land and Plants

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:9–13*

Story Summary: God brought dry land out of the water and covered it with trees, flowers, fruits, and grasses. He made everything grow and provide food and beauty. This reminds us that God is our Provider, Creator, and Jesus used stories about seeds, trees, and vines to teach us how we grow in Him.

WEEK 4: God Made the Sun, Moon, and Stars

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:14–19*

Story Summary: God created lights to rule the day and night. The sun shines bright, and the moon and stars light up the night sky. These lights help mark time and give light to the world. The Bible says Jesus is the light of the world, guiding us and shining His light in our hearts!

Family Discussion Questions

WEEK 1: God Made Light

1. What do you love most about the light—sunshine, lamps, stars, or something else?
2. Why do you think God created light first?
3. How does Jesus bring light into your heart or life?

WEEK 2: God Made the Sky and Water

1. What do you see when you look at the sky or ocean that reminds you of God?
2. What do sky and water help you appreciate about God?
3. How does Jesus show He is powerful like the God of creation?

WEEK 3: God Made Land and Plants

1. What are your favorite things that grow on land?
2. Why do you think God made the world so full of colors and life?
3. How can we grow in our relationship with God like a tree or plant?

WEEK 4: God Made the Sun, Moon, and Stars

1. What's your favorite thing to see in the sky—sun, moon, or stars?
2. How does the night sky help you think about God?
3. How does Jesus shine His light in your life?

WEEK 5: God Made Birds and Fish

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:20-23*

Story Summary: God filled the skies with birds and the waters with fish and sea creatures. Each one shows His creativity from tiny hummingbirds to giant whales! Jesus said, "Look at the birds. God takes care of them-don't you know He'll take care of you, too?" Creation reminds us that we can trust the goodness of God!

WEEK 6: God Made Animals and People

Bible Focus: *Genesis 1:24-31*

Story Summary: God created all the animals that walk on land-and then He made people. He made humans in His own image, to reflect His love, wisdom, and creativity. People are God's most special creation! Jesus came to show us what it means to live as God's children and bring us back into close relationship with Him

WEEK 7: God Rested

Bible Focus: *Genesis 2:1-3*

Story Summary: God After six days of creating, God rested. He wasn't tired-He was setting an example for us to pause, enjoy, and worship. The seventh day reminds us to stop, remember God's goodness, and trust Him. Jesus also rested and spent time with His Father. He invites us to find rest in Him today!

WEEK 4: God Made Everything, Including Me!

Bible Focus: *Psalms 139:14 Genesis 1:31*

Story Summary: God made the whole world-light, sky, land, animals-and He also made YOU! The Bible says we are fearfully and wonderfully made. That means you were made with care, purpose, and love. Through Jesus, we see just how special we are to God-so special that He came to rescue us and be with us forever.

3. What does it mean to you that Jesus loves you just as you are?
