



What is Known?

Known is our Calvary Women's Spring Event, an invitation to step into a deeper experience of being truly "Known" —known by God and known by one another. We have a beautiful two days of teaching from Pastor Mary Armstrong, worship, fellowship, stories, and so much more!

When and where is Known taking place?

Known is taking place at Calvary Community Church. On Friday, May 15th, the sanctuary doors will open at 6:30pm, with desserts available in the foyer, and the event will go from 7-8:30pm.

On Saturday, May 16th, you may arrive anytime between 8-9am to get a light breakfast, and the event will go from 9am-noon.

Do I need to register?

Yes, registration is required so that we can make accurate preparations for food and seating during our time together. Tickets are \$15 each. We do have scholarships and partial scholarships available; you just need to check the box on the registration form.

What age is Known appropriate for?

This event is great for ages middle school and up.

What can I expect on Friday evening?

We will start our evening with desserts and fellowship in the foyer, and the Calvary Cafe will be open. The doors to the sanctuary will open at 6:30pm, and at 7pm, we'll move into the sanctuary where together, Pastor Mary Armstrong and her team will guide us into a sacred pause, where we reflect on the lives of women in Scripture and those from generations before us—women who courageously spoke truth into the deepest places of the human heart. Through this, in Session One, we'll explore "The Power of Our Words" and how they shape identity, healing, and connection.

What can I expect on Saturday morning?

On Saturday, we will come back together for breakfast, which will be available from 8-9am. At 9am, we'll pick up where we left off Friday evening, discovering what women in the Bible were willing to exchange to be fully known by God. "The Power of Surrender and Obedience in the Newness of Each Day" will be the teaching during session 2, and we'll conclude our time together in session 3 with a powerful teaching on "Why Party?"—embracing how we are designed to rejoice in God's holy presence.

What kind of food is being served at Known?

On Friday evening, we will be serving desserts in the foyer including a selection of tasty cookies, brownies, and fruit. Saturday morning we invite you to come anytime between 8-9am for breakfast burritos and we will have some light snacks available. The Calvary Café will also be open before the event begins both days.

Will there be childcare available?

Childcare is limited, and will only be available on Friday, May 15th for women who cannot attend the event without it. If you need childcare, there is a box for childcare on the registration form and someone from the Women's Team will email you a form to sign up your children.

Is my ticket refundable?

Unfortunately, all tickets sold are non-refundable. We apologize for any inconvenience.

What if I can only attend one day, or leave early?

Yes, that is totally fine! If you can only attend for one of the two days, or need to leave early, especially on Saturday morning, we still encourage you to come for as long as you can.

Can I invite someone that does not attend Calvary?

All of Women's Ministry events are outreach opportunities to invite women that may not attend an event at Church otherwise! We would love to have your friends and family that do not attend Calvary join us!

What do I do if I don't have someone that I'd like to bring with me, but I would still like to sponsor a ticket for someone else who may not be able to afford it? How would I do that?

When you register to join us, towards the bottom is a payment section. There you will add the ticket for yourself and or your friends and then there is a second line that discusses donating a ticket to the event, you may add tickets there and we will make sure that people know they are sponsored by amazing people like you! We will give away the ticket you donated.
