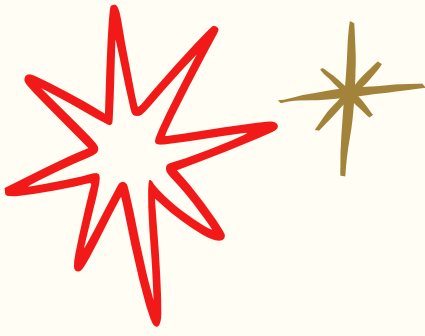


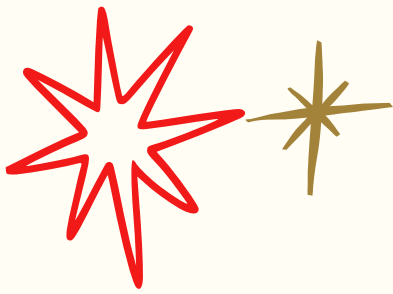


JOIN US AS WE COUNTDOWN TO CHRISTMAS!

DAY 1

Verse: Luke 2:10 'But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people.'

Reflection: Jesus' Birth brings Joy to the world

Activity: Draw or write one way you can bring Joy to someone today.

DAY 2

Verse: Isaiah 9:6 'For to us a child is born ... and he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God.'

Reflection: God promised to send a Savior - and He did!

Activity: Draw or write about a time Jesus helped you.

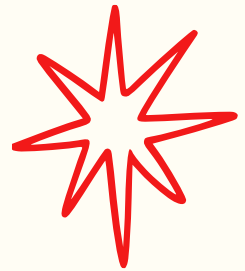


DAY 3

Verse: Luke 1:31 'You will give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus.'

Reflection: Mary trusted God's plan even when it was surprising.

Activity: Draw or write about a time you trusted God when you didn't understand everything.



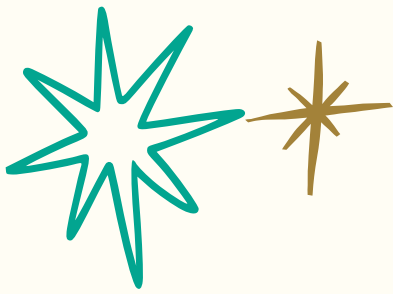
DAY 4

Verse: Luke 1:26-27 'God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, to a young woman named Mary'

Reflection: God sends His messages in amazing ways!

Activity: Create a kind message to encourage someone in your home or school.





DAY 5

Verse: Matthew 1:20 'An angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream.'

Reflection: Joseph listened to God even when it was hard.

Activity: Draw a picture of Joseph and Mary on their journey to Bethlehem.

DAY 6

Verse: Luke 2:4 'So Joseph went to Bethlehem, the town of David.'

Reflection: Sometimes following God's plan takes patience and courage.

Activity: Think of a time God helped you be brave. Draw or write about it.

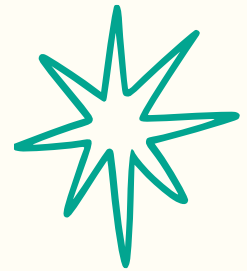


DAY 7

Verse: Luke 2:7 'There was no guest room available for them'

Reflection: Jesus was born in a humble place - but He is our King!

Activity: Draw a picture of the stable.



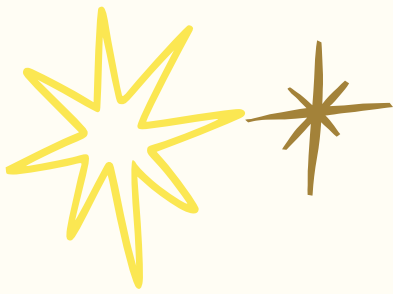
DAY 8

Verse: Luke 2:8-9 'An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and they were terrified'

Reflection: God's good news came to ordinary people first.

Activity: Do a brainstorm and list ordinary people God used in the Bible.





DAY 9

Verse: Luke 2:11 'Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you'

Reflection: Jesus came to save you!

Activity: Tell someone today that Jesus loves them!

DAY 10

Verse: Luke 2: 13-14 "Glory to God in the highest heaven!"

Reflection: The angels couldn't stop singing because Jesus had come!

Activity: Sing your favorite Christmas song to praise God!

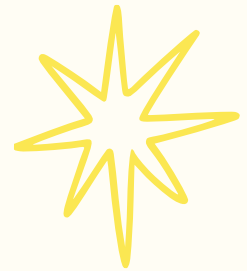


DAY 11

Verse: Matthew 2:2 "We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him"

Reflection: The star showed the way to Jesus - He is our light too.

Activity: Draw a picture of a star to remind you that Jesus is our light.



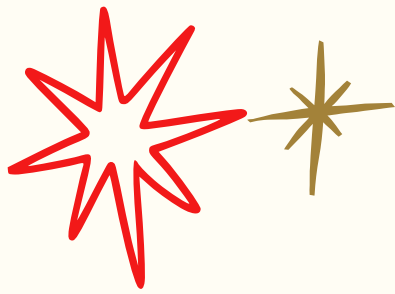
DAY 12

Verse: Matthew 2:10 "When they saw the star, they were filled with joy."

Reflection: God guided the wise men to Jesus. God also guides us today when we listen and trust Him.

Activity: Write one prayer asking God to help you follow Him this week.





DAY 13

Verse: 2 Corinthians 1:20 "For no matter how many promises God has made, they are Yes' in Christ"

Reflection: Jesus' birth shows us that God keeps His promises. even when we have to wait.

Activity: Draw something you are waiting or hoping for. Ask God to help you wait with trust.

DAY 14

Verse: Psalm 23:1 "The Lord is my shepherd; I have everything I need."

Reflection: Just like a shepherd cares for every sheep. God cares for us. He knows what we need and watches over us with love.

Activity: Draw a sheep. Inside the sheep's wool write things that God gives you that shows you He cares for you.

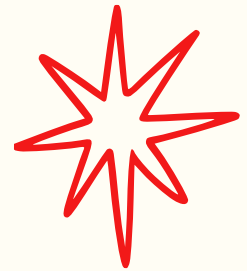


DAY 15

Verse: Isaiah 12:5 "Sing to the Lord, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world."

Reflection: The story of Jesus' birth is not quiet news: it is joy that echoes across the earth. It reminds us to share the goodness of God.

Activity: Share with someone who Jesus is to you today.



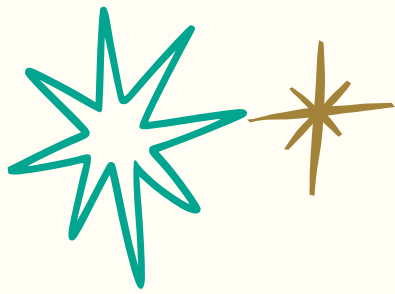
DAY 16

Verse: John 1:9 "The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world"

Reflection: Jesus is described as the true light - a light that brings hope to everyone. At Christmas. we remember that Jesus came to shine His Light into the world.

Activity: Write or draw one way you can be a "light" to someone today!





DAY 17

Verse: Matthew 1:21 "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Reflection: Jesus came to save us and forgive us for all the things we've done and will do wrong

Activity: Sing your favourite worship song and give thanks to God for saving you.

DAY 18

Verse: Philippians 4:4 "Rejoice in the Lord always."

Reflection: We can be joyful every day not just on Christmas.

Activity: Write three things you're thankful for today.

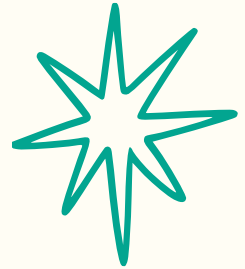


DAY 19

Verse: 2 Corinthians 9:15 "Thanks be to God for His gift that is too wonderful for words!"

Reflection: The best gift isn't found under the tree - It's Jesus.

Activity: Draw a picture of a gift and write the name Jesus inside.



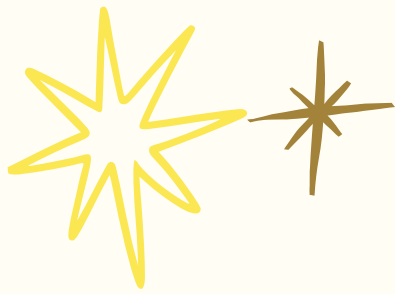
DAY 20

Verse: Mark 16:15 "Go into all the world and tell the good news."

Reflection: We can share Jesus' story just like the shepherds did!

Activity: Make a Christmas card that shares God's love and give it to someone.





DAY 21

Verse: Romans 8:28 "In all things God works for the good of those who love him."

Reflection: God had a plan for Jesus' birth - and He has a plan for you too!

Activity: Draw a picture of a compass to remind you that God is always guiding the way.

DAY 22

Verse: Psalm 100:4 "Enter His gates with thanksgiving."

Reflection: A thankful heart brings us closer to God.

Activity: Write a prayer of thanks.

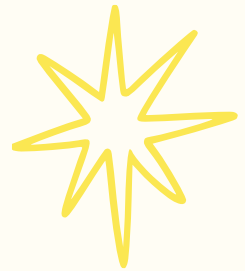


DAY 23

Verse: Matthew 1:23 "They will call him Emmanuel, which means 'God with us.'"

Reflection: Jesus is always near - you are never alone.

Activity: Draw Jesus next to you doing something you love.



DAY 24

Verse: Luke 2:7 "She gave birth to her firstborn, a son"

Reflection: The greatest day - Jesus is here!

Activity: Draw a "Happy Birthday" picture to celebrate Jesus' birth!
