



From the Administrative Board

At the end of December 2021, CUMC was blessed with special gifts of almost \$600,000. According to the United Methodist Book of Discipline, the Board of Trustees are responsible for overseeing the acceptance, management and distribution of estates and bequests given to the church.

In January, the Administrative Board voted to adopt a Large Gift Discernment Process. This process determined steps to receive input from all members of CUMC in the long-term use of the gifts. Crestwood UMC is focused on being ONE TEAM with ONE PURPOSE and MANY GIFTS.

In February, we CELEBRATED these gifts in worship and with leadership teams. After Celebration Sunday, surveys were sent to the congregation & listening sessions were held in April for in person discussions. The Administrative Board met with Council on Ministries and the Endowment Committee.

We WAITED for God's guidance, we PRAYED for guidance and wisdom and we started to LISTEN & LEARN from donors, other congregations & all interested parties at CUMC.

The feedback received resulted in six key ministry themes:

- 1. Fully Accessible and Easy to Navigate Campus
- 2. Upgrade of Meeting Areas for Adults, Youth, and Children
- 3. Purchase of a Church Van or Bus
- 4. Kilgus House and Empty Lot Upgrades for Missions and Ministries
- 5. General Fund (Emergency Reserve Account)
- 6. Gift to Endowment

Each ministry theme was assigned to various teams made up of members from Staff, Council on Ministries and/or Trustees to put together proposals with specific gift requests. In September, Administrative Board and Trustees met to review all ministry proposals. At that time, votes were taken, and the following amounts were approved as guidance and priorities for the use of the gifts (Note that many dollar amounts shown are budgetary figures as specific bids are still needed):

- General Fund (Emergency Reserve Acct) Two-month Emergency Fund Reserve with possibility of using a portion of one month as cashflow start for 2023 budget. Approved amount: \$114,000
- Endowment It is estimated that once the principal reaches \$250,000 there will be \$12,000-\$15,000 per year that could be used by ministry teams outside of their budget. The fund is currently around \$119,000. The Endowment Committee will set up a grant process where ministry teams can apply for funds. Approved amount: \$100,000
- Church Bus/Van start a Church Bus Ministry at CUMC by purchasing a 15-passenger bus (no CDL).
- A Bus Ministry Team, along with Trustees, will evaluate bids and develop a plan. Approved: ~\$125,000
- **Kilgus House Upgrade**s for current & future Mission Opportunities and Small Group Meeting Space– Make needed repairs to the exterior "envelope" (siding, windows, etc.) so the building can be more effective. Approved: ~\$75,000
- Empty Lot Upgrades for Missions clearing and cleaning the lot, providing an outdoor space with a pavilion for fellowship, worship, and community interaction opportunities. Approved: ~\$45,000.
- Upgrade of Meeting Areas The ministry staff of Crestwood UMC requested that money be set aside for upgrades for adult Sunday School/small group classes, youth space, and children's ministries. The Discipleship, Youth and Children's Teams will develop detailed plans for the ministry area upgrades. The plans will be approved before money is spent. Approved: ~\$70,000
- Fully Accessible & Easy to Navigate Campus connection of all buildings to enhance safety and provide a friendly environment. Options presented include A) Attachment of the 2 buildings, Fellowship Hall to Sanctuary \$200k. B) Attachment of CLC to Education Building \$65k. C) Upgrade/Enlarge both Men's & Women's Bathrooms in Sanctuary \$45k. It was agreed that \$20,000 be set aside to hire an architect to develop plans. Once plans are received, more decisions can be made and could involve a capital campaign. Approved: ~\$20,000

From the total gifts received, a budgetary amount of \$549,000 was set aside. This leaves \$39,000 that will be held. As detailed costs are determined, future decisions about the remaining amounts will be made.

We would like to thank everyone that has been involved in the steps of this process. It would not have been possible without your prayers, your input, and your commitment to this process. As we proceed with each of these ministries, if you feel led to get more involved in any of these areas, please let us know. We're excited to see where God takes us next in all these exciting new ministry opportunities!
