Dear Crestwood UMC,

Thank you for your generosity towards Crestwood UMC during 2023. God has done amazing things, and your generosity helps make that happen! We are in the middle of our stewardship campaign for 2024: "Together as One". And we know and believe that God is adding to our number daily those who are being saved!

Specifically, we are encouraging all of the congregation to:

- Finish strong in their giving for 2023! (See good news below!)

- Pray about taking a \$500 step forward in your annual pledge for 2024. If we do this "Together as
 One" we will have over \$50,000 more than we did in 2023! Is \$500 a stretch? Maybe a \$100 or
 \$250 step. Is \$500 not a stretch? What about a \$750 or \$1,000 step forward. See, "Together as

You can see the campaign's progress on page 2. We have exciting news about Finishing Strong in 2023. God moved in one of our members hearts and they have committed to match up to \$30,000 in "Finish Strong Civing." Here is what they had to say:

"I was very moved on October 29 during the stewardship challenge. Specifically, the first challenge that we finish strong in our giving and fulfilling our pledges for 2023. I've noticed since June that our actual giving has not kept up with our estimated giving. I've also noticed that our ministries to the church and the community have continued to thrive. Last week we were behind right at \$60,000 in giving for 2023 compared to budget needed. I know that there are multiple reasons for this, but when Pastor Derek was challenging us to "finish strong for 2023" I asked myself, "What can I do to help my church that I love." I felt lead to encourage the church to join me in closing that deficit so I told my pastor that I would match up to \$30,000 in "Finish Strong Giving." Specifically, giving to catch up in your pledge or giving above and beyond your pledge. Pastor Derek challenged us "Together as One" to "Finish Strong" and this is something I could do to help my church. I hope people will join me in making a "Finish Strong" donation in 2023. We are unbelievably blessed by our pastor, church staff and ministries of our church. Let's finish strong!"

- 3. Pray about taking a \$500 per year step forward in your pledge for 2024.



How to Setup Online Giving

Getting Started

- Make sure you have the following before you get started:
- Email Address & Password of your choice.
- Credit Card Number, Expiration Date, and CVV as well as the billing address OR
- Checking account number and routing number.
- The amount and frequency of your gift.

Finding online giving:

- 1. Open your computer's browser.
- 2. Type in CrestwoodMethodist.com/give.
- 3. Scroll down to the button that says online giving and click the box.

Create an Account:

- 1. At the top right of your screen click on the lighter purple box that says SIGN IN/CREATE ACCOUNT.
- 2.A new box will appear that says: "Sign In". If you are creating a brand-new account, click the box on the bottom that says: "CREATE NEW ACCOUNT".
- 3. Enter your information in the boxes. Passwords must be at least 7 characters with 1 upper & 1 lowercase letter and 1 special character. When completed, click the "CREATE ACCOUNT" button.
- 4. Two factor authentication is always a good idea to protect your account.

Setting up a Gift:

- 1. Once you have your account created, you can now add your gift. Gifts can be any of the following:
 - a. One Time Gift
 - b. Reoccurring Cift on any schedule (weekly, monthly, etc.)
 - c. Filling a predetermined pledge amount over any specified period of time.
- 2. Have your credit card information or bank information ready now.
- 3. In the Upcoming Gifts window, click the "ADD GIFT" button in the upper right corner of that window.
- 4. A new window will pop up, click the GIVE NOW button.
- 5. Enter the gift amount, frequency, start date and any notes about the gift if applicable. Click the green "CONTINUE" button.
- 6. Click "Select Payment Method" and they click "Add New Payment Method".
- 7. Enter your payment information and click "Submit".
- 8. You will need to verify your information is being entered by a human by following the instructions on the Captcha challenge. Captcha will ask you to click on the images that match the word in the blue box. Click verify and you are done!
