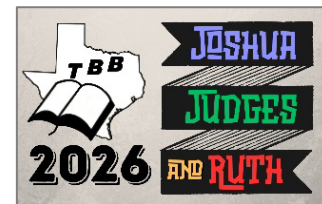

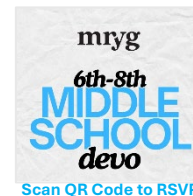

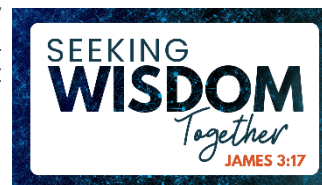


Trunk or Treat *Sign up as a Trunk Host today!*

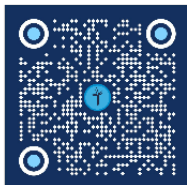

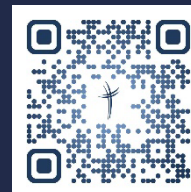
