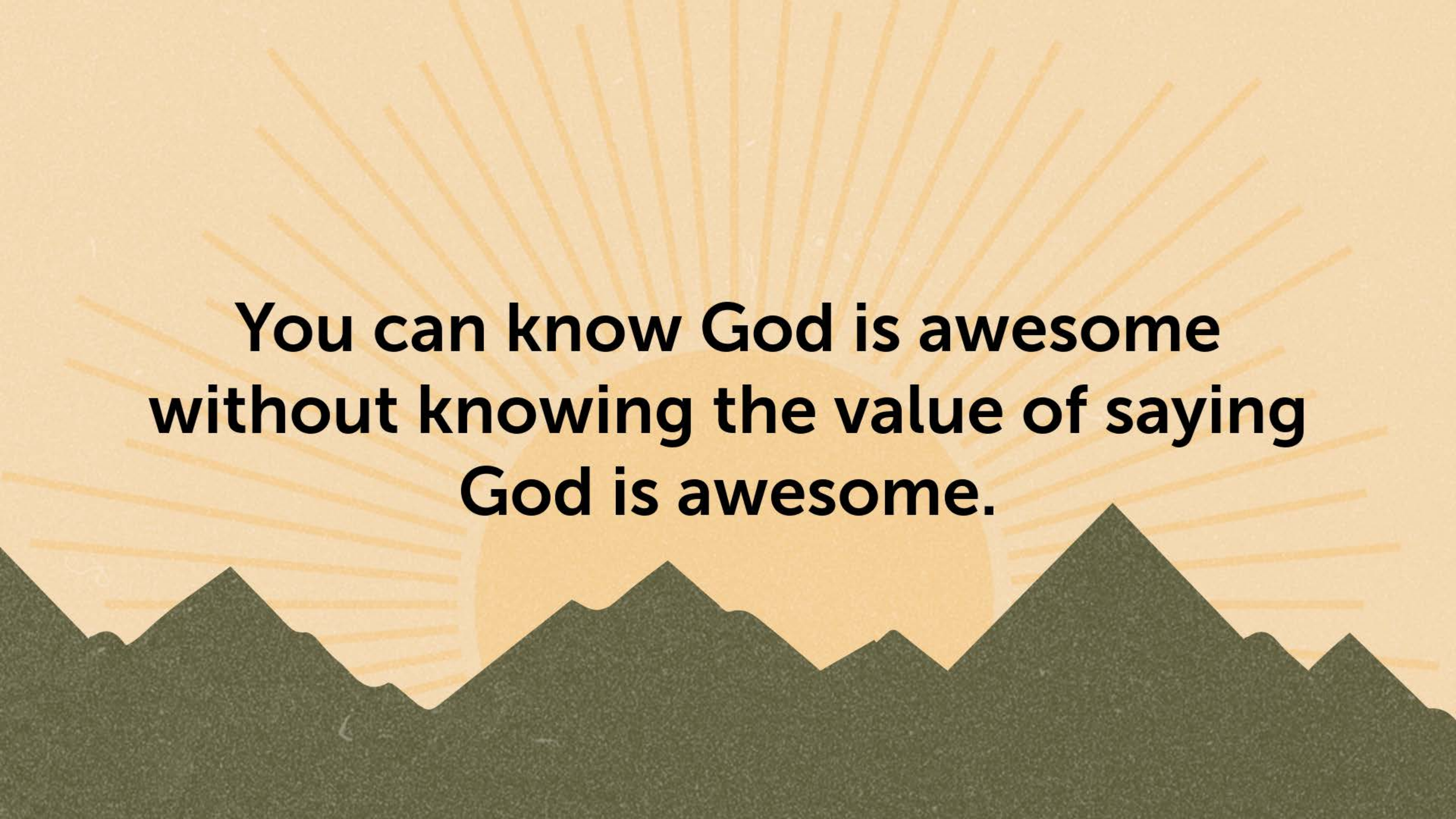




AWESOME GOD

ESV

In you, O LORD, do I take refuge; let me never be put to shame! ² In your righteousness **deliver** me and **rescue** me; incline your ear to me, and **save** me! ³ Be to me a rock of refuge, to which I may continually come; you have given the command to **save** me, for you are my rock and my fortress.



Psalm 71:4–6

ESV

⁴ Rescue me, O my God, from the hand of the wicked, from the grasp of the unjust and cruel man. ⁵ For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O LORD, **from my youth.** ⁶ Upon you **I have leaned from before my birth**; you are he who took me from my mother's womb. My praise is **continually** of you.

⁷ I have been as a **portent** to many, but you are my strong refuge.



Psalm 71:8

ESV

⁸ My mouth is **filled with your praise**, and with your glory all the day.



Psalm 71:9–11

ESV

⁹ Do not cast me off in the time of **old age**;
forsake me not when my **strength is spent**.¹⁰ For
my enemies speak concerning me; those who
watch for my life consult together¹¹ and say, "God
has forsaken him; pursue and seize him, for there
is none to deliver him."



Psalm 71:12–13

ESV

¹² O God, be not far from me; O my God, **make haste to help me!** ¹³ May my accusers be put to shame and consumed; with scorn and disgrace may they be covered who seek my hurt.



Psalm 71:14–16

ESV

¹⁴ But I will **hope** continually and will **praise** you yet more and more. ¹⁵ My mouth will **tell** of your righteous acts, of your deeds of salvation all the day, for their number is past my knowledge. ¹⁶ With the mighty deeds of the Lord GOD I will come; I will **remind them** of your righteousness, yours alone.



Psalm 71:17–19

ESV

¹⁷ O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim **your wondrous deeds**. ¹⁸ So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim **your might** to another generation, **your power** to all those to come. ¹⁹ **Your righteousness**, O God, reaches the high heavens. You who have done great things, O God, **who is like you?**

ESV

²⁰ You who have made me see many troubles and calamities will **revive me again**; from the **depths of the earth** you will **bring me up again**. ²¹ You will increase my greatness and comfort me again.

ESV

²² I will also **praise you** with the harp for your faithfulness, O my God; I will **sing praises** to you with the lyre, O Holy One of Israel. ²³ My lips will **shout for joy**, when I **sing praises to you**; my soul also, which you have redeemed.

²⁴ And my tongue will **talk of your righteous help all the day long**, for they have been put to shame and disappointed who sought to do me hurt.
