

We are Called To ...

- **March 3 - Be a Light to the World (Matthew 5:14-16)**
 - Being Called to More is not just a slogan; it's a rallying cry to look at ourselves and the world around us. As we reflect the Lord's love for everyone, we become a light for the world. Today, ask the Lord to help us to feel His love so that we can share it with the world and open our eyes to help us see the world as He sees it, a world that is broken, but a world worth giving our lives for.
- **March 4 - Be a City on a Hill (Matthew 5:14, Psalm 9:9)**
 - We are called to be a place of refuge for those who need it. We should welcome everyone, no matter what they've done in the past. It was always part of His plan for His church to be a sanctuary for the sinner, the broken, the killer, the wounded. Today, let's ask the Lord what else we can do in our daily lives to welcome those who need the Lord.
- **March 5 - Bear Fruit (Psalm 1)**
 - We all need help to become the righteous person that He wants us to be. We all want to bear good fruit for the Lord, but how do we start this journey? According to Psalm 1, it's by meditating on the law of the Lord. Take time to go through this psalm 3 times today- morning, noon and night. Consider how our lives change when we are fed with the living word.
- **March 6 - Use Our Talents (Matthew 25:14-30, Luke 19:11-27)**
 - Thank the Lord for the incredible blessings that He has given us! We have been blessed beyond measure with talents in this body of believers. However, this comes with responsibility. Knowing how much we've been blessed, how can we be like the servant who was called "good and faithful?" Read these scriptures and ask the Lord how you can help bless this body of believers today and in the future.
- **March 7 - Do His will (Proverbs 3:5-6)**
 - How do we shift our mindset from craving our heart's desires to what He wants? We start by trusting Him in the small things, and that grows over time, helping us when the big things come along. We trust Him and His ways, and if He is behind something, then no matter how insurmountable it seems, the path will open up before us. Ask the Lord today what challenges in your life you can give over to Him.
- **March 8 - Unity (Acts 4:32-37)**
 - The early church showed a radical form of love and connection to each other. Not all of us are in a position to sell our houses and give the proceeds to the needy, but when we look around at our church family, who can we bless this week? Ask the Lord to show you whom you can bless so that we can truly say that there is no needy among us.
- **March 9 - Deeper Connection in Bible Classes (Acts 2:42)**
 - When the early church came to know the Lord, they devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to fellowship. We want to do the same thing when we gather each week. We connect through learning and fellowshiping together. Today, let's ask the Lord to continue blessing our Bible class time so we can learn and grow together.
