

## We are Called To ...

- **March 10 - Connection in Life Groups (Hebrews 10:24-25)**

Being a Christian is not an individual sport; we need people who are willing to hold us accountable and challenge us to grow. We praise the Lord for the many small groups we have who are living life together and challenging each other to follow Jesus more each day. Ask the Lord today how you can support those in your small group and encourage your group to find ways to love and to stir up work for Him.

- **March 11 - Connection in Bible Studies (Proverbs 1:1-7 and 18:15)**

The Bible is like a pool that is shallow enough for a mouse to wade in, yet is deep enough for an elephant to swim in. Anyone can read the Bible and have a basic understanding, but there are deeper things that can truly stir the heart if we take the time to study them. We thank the Lord for giving us teachers who can teach both the simple and the complex, and we pray that He continues to guide our teachers and those who run Bible studies for this family. Take time today to pray for those who prepare and teach the Bible studies.

- **March 12 - Connection by Gathering Around the Table**

Our Lord showed us over and over again that some of the best connections come from sharing a meal with someone. We eat with the ones we love, and for some, that love is the first step to them knowing our Lord through us. This is perhaps one of the reasons why we are called to share a meal together every week. Who is someone in your life that you want to draw closer to that you can share a meal with this week? Take time today and pray for that person and make a plan to share a meal with them this week.

- **March 13 - Connection in Showing Hospitality (Romans 12:9-13, Hebrews 13:2)**

Followers of our Lord have long been known for the care of others. We give, we feed, we welcome, we clothe, we visit, we care. Why? Simply because Our Lord did them for us when we didn't deserve it, and we follow His example. We show the love of Jesus to those who need it, even when the world says they don't deserve it. Ask the Lord to show you someone in your life today that needs you to welcome them into your life, and be prepared to do for them as our Lord has done for you.

- **March 14 - Open Our Eyes to How God Would Have Us Connect (2 Kings 6:17)**

Sometimes, like Elisha's servant, we are so blind to the true reality that is around us. We don't look through His eyes, so we don't see the struggles of our brothers and sisters. There are so many ways we can connect with each other, yet so many of His children don't feel connected. There are lonely people outside of our walls, but there are also lonely people inside our walls. Ask the Lord to help guide you to them this week, and then take the time to help them feel like a part of the family.

- **March 15 - Called to More Service in Our Daily Lives (Joshua 24:15, Colossians 3:23-24)**

On the day we decided to follow our Lord, we said that His will is greater, His plans are better and His will is more important than our will. There are so many ways that we can serve both in this family and in our lives. Ask the Lord to show you today how you can serve Him by serving those around you, and when you see what you can do, do it with all your heart, soul, and strength.

- **March 16 - Called to More in Hearts and Hands (Psalm 127:3-5, Proverbs 19:17, Luke 14:13-14)**

Our Lord has a soft spot for those who have been ignored or forgotten about. Children, whether in Haiti or in a NICU, are beloved by our Lord. All people, whether they have a house to live in or not, are made in the image of God and deserve to be treated as such. Today, ask the Lord to open our eyes to those who are ignored and how we can support ministries like Hearts and Hands that support them.
