ESV

² O LORD, how long shall I cry for **help**, and you will not hear? Or cry to you “**Violence!**” and you will not save? ³ Why do you make me see **iniquity**, and why do you idly look at **wrong**? **Destruction** and **violence** are before me; **strife** and **contention** arise. ⁴ So the law is paralyzed, and justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround the righteous; so **justice goes forth perverted**.

^{1:5} "Look at the nations and pay attention! You will be shocked and amazed! For I will do something in your lifetime that you will not believe even though you are forewarned. ^{1:6} Look, I am about to **empower the Babylonians, that ruthless and greedy nation**. They sweep across the surface of the earth, seizing dwelling places that do not belong to them. ^{1:7} They are frightening and terrifying; they decide for themselves what is right.

ESV

¹² Are you not from everlasting, O LORD my God, my Holy One? We shall not die. O LORD, you have ordained them as a judgment, and you, O Rock, have established them for reproof. ¹³ You who are of purer eyes than to see evil and cannot look at wrong, why do you **idly** look at traitors and **remain silent** when the wicked swallows up the man more righteous than he?

ESV

I will take my stand at my watchpost and station myself on the tower, and look out to see what he will say to me, and what I will answer **concerning my complaint.**

ESV

² And the LORD answered me: “Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it. ³ For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie. **If it seems slow, wait for it;** it will surely come; it will not delay.

⁴ "See, the enemy is puffed up; his desires are not upright — but the righteous person will **live by his faithfulness** —

¹⁸ yet I will **rejoice** in the LORD; I will take **joy** in the God of my salvation. ¹⁹ GOD, the Lord, is my **strength**; he makes my feet like the deer's; he makes me tread on my high places.
