²¹ For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an **example**, so that you might **follow in his steps**. ²² He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth. ²³ When he was reviled, he **did not revile in return**; when he suffered, he **did not threaten**, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.
