


















#### Heavenly Father,

# **HOW DO WE LEARN TO WALK IN THE WISDOM OF GOD?**

Proverbs begins with provocative statements outlining two foolish postures: (v4) אַנָּלָם 'simple' fools and (v7) אֵנִילָּם 'stubborn' fools

יְרְאָּה: "Fear" has a range of meaning, in this context: awe, reverence, wonder, worship. The worship & wonder of God positions us to be guidable; only the guidable can be wise. The guidable can defer to God's ways, fools cling to their ways.





### 1 Corinthians 11:23-25

On the night that our Lord was betrayed, He took the bread, and when he had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is my body, given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

In the same way, after supper He took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
