
We have not cried out for justice nor cared about those who are without Christ and without hope in this world. Merciful God, we are thankful that your forgiving grace goes further than all our sin.

These things we ask in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.








I once was lost in darkest night, yet thought I knew the way
