

THE GOSPEL PROJECT Unit 6.4 Worship God Alone

Date: Sunday November 2, 2025 Teachers: Jourdan M(lead), Jason D
Bible Passage: Deuteronomy 1; 3:23–4:40 Key Passage: Deuteronomy 6:4
Props: ** from home: at centre: cut out hearts out of construction paper

REVIEW RULES:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)
Speak Kind words like our God three in ONE!

LESSON INTRO: "God is faithful" materials: (pictures of the Bible Story)

Help the kids order the pictures, God did so many amazing things to set His people free, and let them know He was their God, he created them to worship Him and Love Him first. I

GOSPEL GEMS

God is holy; He always does what is right.

There is no one like God.

Sing to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb":

"Holy, holy is the Lord, is the Lord, is the Lord! Holy, holy is the Lord. He alone is God."

GOD IS HOLY. God always does what is right and good. God sent Jesus because He loves us.

KEY PASSAGE VERSE: "The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your strength. Deuteronomy 6:4 (kids do actions/point to hearts/point to gut/make a fist)

ACTIVITY: "Hunt for hearts" materials: cut out hearts with #1 on them (make before class)

Write the number 1 on several heart cutouts and hide them in plain sight around the room. Invite toddlers to find the hearts and bring them to you.

Each of these hearts had the number 1 on it. There is only one God, who made us and takes care of us. God is holy. People should only worship God!

ACTIVITY: "Wander the desert"

Invite the preschoolers to follow you as you play out the Israelites' wandering through the desert on their way to the promised land. Guide children to repeat your actions. Play out being hot, hungry, and thirsty.

God brought His people to the promised land, but they didn't go in! They didn't trust God to keep His promises. God made them walk in the desert for 40 years. Now the people were back at the promised land. Moses had an important message for them. Today we're going to learn what Moses said to the Israelites

ACTIVITY: "Remember what God has done" materials: (object to pass, bean bag or block)

Encourage kids to tell something that God has done for him or something for which he is thankful. Offer ideas to preschoolers who may struggle to think of something (gave you a family, gives you food to eat, made you to be able

to play and run) Good job remembering what God has done for you! God loves it when we remember and thank Him for the good things He has done. Today we are going to learn that people should worship only God because the Lord alone is God.
