Props: From home **bring in a few buns or bread from home OR use arrowroot's if necessary

At centre: activity sheets in folder

BIBLE STORY FOR TODDLERS: READ GOD'S BIG PICTURE STORY BOOK P.222 "Road to Emmaus"

OBJECT LESSON: "Which way?" materials: (activity sheet with lesson)

Show kids with a pen the road to travel. Our story today is about some disciples that were walking on the road to Jerusalem and they were sad about the news that Jesus had died (they had not heard Jesus is alive). Jesus appeared to them, but they did not recognize him. Jesus said, the Bible is ONE big story and it's all about Me!

ACTIVITY "Jesus is Alive!"

Line up kids on one side of the room and call a toddler by name and invite her to run back and tell her friends that Jesus is alive as you say it with her. If she is non-verbal, she can give a friend a hug or a high-five as you tell the good news. Two friends saw Jesus alive, and right away they went to tell the other friends the good news. JESUS IS ALIVE!

ACTIVITY "Breaking bread" materials: (**bring in a few buns or bread from home OR use arrowroot's)

Jesus was having a meal with the disciples he had just been walking on the road with. They wanted him to share more with them about God's word and all the stories telling about Messiah Jesus. Jesus broke bread and gave it to them and their eyes were opened and they saw Jesus as the one who came to rescue them. When Jesus broke the bread- they would see the scars on his hands that were scars of his act of love on the cross. (break bread and hand a small piece to each child)
