



THE GOSPEL PROJECT PK Unit 11. 2 Wisdom for God's people

Date: Sunday May 3, 2026 **Teachers:** Janet H (lead) , Taylor/Jason D

Bible Passage: Proverbs 1:1-7; 3:1-12; 4:10-19 **Key Passage:** Proverbs 2:6-7

Props: from home: none. **At centre** (activity sheet)

Review Rules:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)

Speak Kind Words like our God 3 in One

INTRO BIBLE STORY: materials: activity page

Invite preschoolers to look at the pictures and circle those where children are making wise choices.

Solomon asked God to give him wisdom, and God did. Today we are learning what it means to be wise. Wisdom is God's invitation to trust his way for having life according to His plan.

BIBLE STORY VIDEO: God gives wisdom to His People

SING A SONG: Sing to the tune of "The More We Get Together" :

"The Bible is God's words; it's God's words, it's God's words!

The Bible is God's words, and God's words are *true."

King Solomon asked God to make him wise. GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING. We are wise when we listen to God's voice.

KEY PASSAGE: PLAY KEY PASSAGE SONG

"The Lord gives wisdom, from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding" Prov. 2:6-7

ACTIVITY: "Choose wisely" materials: Print and cut out the "Choose Wisely Pictures."

Explain to preschoolers that you are going to make a statement and hold up two choices. Invite preschoolers to tell you which is the wise choice.

1. You want to eat a snack. (fruit or candy)
2. It is cold outside. (coat or shorts)
3. It is raining outside. (umbrella or backpack)
4. You want to play basketball. (basketball or soccerball)
5. You are eating chicken noodle soup. (fork or spoon)
6. You want to paint a picture. (paintbrush or rake)

Good job deciding which is the wise choice! The Bible is God's gift of wise instruction to us, it doesn't always tell us exactly what to do, so we need to learn it and pray and trust God and begin to learn **God's ways make us wise.**

ACTIVITY: "Play a memory game" **materials:** "Words of Wisdom" printable cut out the cards and arrange them in a grid. Invite preschoolers to turn over two cards at a time to find a match. As preschoolers turn over the cards, read the words of wisdom on each card. Wisdom is loving God and obeying His Word. We need to hear God's words over and over again so we can know what it looks like to obey God. But even then, we aren't able to obey God perfectly. We still make selfish and foolish choices. God had a plan to help us walk in God's ways and be wise. God would come to us in Jesus and give us life, and give us His Spirit to help us walk in His ways. Wisdom comes from listening to God.

ACTIVITY: "Play musical chairs" **materials:** (chairs, song from your phone)

Play a game of musical chairs to help preschoolers learn. Form a circle of chairs using one less chair than the number of children in your group. Play music. As the music plays, preschoolers should walk around the chairs. When the music stops, all the preschoolers should find a chair. The child is asked this question, Where does wisdom come from? **Wisdom comes from listening to God.** Play again as time allows.

Where does wisdom come from? Wisdom comes from listening to God. Wisdom is loving God and obeying His will and way. We learn God's will and ways by knowing God's word. He made everything and knows how it works best

PRAYER: Thank you God that you are wisdom, may we learn to listen to you and your ways and be wise. Amen
