



THE GOSPEL PROJECT TODDLER Wisdom for God's people

Date: Sunday MAY 3rd, 2026 **Teachers:** Laura N (lead), Sarah R, Paul E

Invite kids to sit in a circle, you can start with a snack.

Rules: Let's listen with our ears. We are going to sit in a circle before we play.

BIBLE STORY:

God made King Solomon very wise. People came from all over to learn from Solomon. Solomon wrote down many wise sayings called proverbs. Solomon wrote that wisdom comes from loving and obeying God. When people do not listen to God's wisdom, they make foolish choices. Solomon wrote that people should trust and obey God. Solomon wrote that it is very important to make wise friends. Foolish friends will only help you make wrong choices. We read about God's wisdom in the Bible.

SING A SONG: Sing to the tune of "The More We Get Together" :

"The Bible is God's words; it's God's words, it's God's words!

The Bible is God's words, and God's words are *true."

King Solomon asked God to make him wise. GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING. Jesus is wise because He is God's Son.

ACTIVITY: "Sleeping bunnies" materials: (none)

Sing the sleeping bunnies song (see the little bunnies sleeping til it's nearly noon/come let us wake them with a merry tune/oh how still/are they ill?/No!/Wake up little bunnies hop hop hop/wake up little bunnies hop hop hop/wake up little bunnies hop and stop. (kids freeze)

In today's Bible story, God spoke to Solomon while he was sleeping.

ACTIVITY: "Guess the animal sounds" materials:

Make animal sounds and invite toddlers to tell you what animal makes that sound. Talk about listening to God's words in the Bible. You knew the sounds because you listened. We get wisdom from listening to God. GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING.

ACTIVITY: "Wise or Foolish" materials: (activity sheet)

Invite preschoolers to look at the pictures and circle/point to those where children are making wise choices.

Solomon asked God to give him wisdom, and God did. Wisdom comes from listening to God's voice. We know what God's voice sounds like by reading and hearing God's word.

ACTIVITY: "Match pictures" materials: (memory cards in folder)

Make a set of Matching Cards. Place the cards faceup on. Invite toddlers to examine them. Help toddlers match the cards. You are very smart! Solomon wrote that wisdom comes from loving God.
