



THE GOSPEL PROJECT PK. Unit 12.1 Wisdom Literature: Solomon

Date: Sunday June 14, 2026 **Teachers:** Brianna D (**lead**), Julianne K

Bible Passage: Job 1–42 **Key Passage:** Psalm 100:5

Props: from home: A doll from home

At centre: bandaids (3-4), transportation toys, colourful bandages for activity, activity sheet

Review Rules:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)

Speak Kind Words like our God 3 in One

INTRO TO BIBLE STORY: materials: (activity sheet)

Show the activity sheet and ask the kids to point to places that God is in control. (ALL of them!) God rules over the world he loves, and even when we can't see God at work we can trust that God is good and is working all things out for His glory and our good.

GOSPEL GEMS

Job was very sad, but he loved God.

SING A SONG: Sing to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb" :

"We are made to live for God, live for God, live for God We are made to live for God, It's what He made us for."

ACTIVITY: "Bandaids of hope" materials: (baby doll from home, bandaids)

Write "God is good" on a few bandaids before class. Help babies stick bandages to the baby. Job was very sick! Job was very sad, but he loved God. Even when sad things happen, we can remember that GOD IS GOOD. Jesus speaks to God for us when we pray.

ACTIVITY: "In Control" materials: (transportation toys from room/bin * if you need more see JR. class bin)

Provide an assortment of transportation toys. Identify a spot and invite preschoolers to drive the transportation toys toward it.

With real cars, trains, and boats, people control where they go. People know how to control them because people made them. God made everything, and He rules over everything! Everything that happens is a part of God's plan. What was happening to Job did not seem good, but God was in control of all of it and God is good. When we don't understand what God is doing, we can remember God is so good, He sent Jesus to give his life for us.

Jesus dying on the cross didn't seem good at all, but it was the best thing for us because it meant giving us life with God as our Father.

ACTIVITY: *"Be a good friend"*

Invite children to hold hands and walk in a circle together, then lift up hands and point up and say "look to Jesus!" Job had friends that were not helpful; they did not encourage him to trust God and believe that God loved him. We are called to be good friends, loving one another and pointing each other to Jesus

PRAYER: We are made for you! Show us your love oh God. Amen

COLOURING ACTIVITY: materials: (band-aids, paper, markers, or crayons)

Give one band-aid to each child to stick to a piece of paper, with a heart drawn on them, they can colour around it
