



## **THE GOSPEL PROJECT TODDLER Unit 12.1 Wisdom Literature: Solomon**

**Date:** Sunday June 14, 2026 **Teachers:** Ryan W (lead), Sarah R, Jess S

**Props: from home:** A doll from home

**At centre:** bandaids (3-4), transportation toys, activity sheet

**We are going to sit in a circle and listen before we play**

### **TODDLER BIBLE STORY:**

God had blessed Job with good things and many children. Job loved God. One day, Job lost everything he had. Job was sick. Job was very sad, but he still loved God. Job's friends were not helpful. They argued with Job and made Job feel sad. Job said, "I wish Someone could speak to God for me." God spoke to Job in the wind! God said, "Were you there when I made the world? Can you understand my plan?" Job said, "You know everything, and nothing can stop your plan!" God blessed Job again. God gave Job more children and more good things, and Job lived a long, happy life.

**ACTIVITY: materials:** (activity sheet)

Show the activity sheet and ask the kids to point to places that God is in control (ALL of them!) God rules over the world he loves, and even when we can't see God at work we can trust that God is good and is working all things out for His glory and our good.

**SING A SONG:** Sing to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb" :

"We are made to live for God, live for God, live for God We are made to live for God, It's what He made us for."

**ACTIVITY: "Bandaids of hope" materials:** (baby doll from home, bandaids)

Write "**God is good**" on a few bandaids before class. Help babies stick bandages to the baby. Job was very sick! Job was very sad, but he loved God. Even when sad things happen, we can remember that GOD IS GOOD. Jesus speaks to God for us when we pray.

**ACTIVITY: "In control" materials:** (transportation toys from room/bin \* if you need more see JR. class bin)

Provide an assortment of transportation toys. Identify a spot and invite toddlers to drive the transportation toys toward it. With real cars, trains, and boats, people control where they go. People know how to control them because people made them. God made everything, and He rules over everything! Everything that happens is a part of God's plan

What was happening to Job did not seem good, but God was in control of all of it and God is good. When we don't understand what God is doing, we can remember God is so good, He sent Jesus to give his life for us.

**ACTIVITY: "Be a good friend"**

Invite children to hold hands and walk in a circle together, then lift up hands and point up and say "look to Jesus!" Job had friends that were not helpful; they did not encourage him to trust God and believe that God loved him. We are called to be good friends, loving one another and pointing each other to Jesus.
