



**SUMMER STORIES OF JESUS Toddler: Jesus calms the storm**

**Date:** Sunday July 5, 2026 **Teachers:** Brooklyn & Brad B(lead), Paul E

**Props: \*bring from home:** large bed sheet

**at centre:** balls from bin

**BIBLE PASSAGE:** Matthew 14

**BIBLE STORY:** *“Jesus and the Big Storm” pg. 172 materials:* God’s BIG Story book Bible

In the Bible, Jesus did something very amazing, he walked on water! Jesus is God so he has power over the water.

**SING A SONG:**

Sing to the tune of “Row, Row, Row Your Boat”:

“Jesus is, Jesus is, Jesus is God’s Son!

He has power o’er everything; Jesus is God’s Son!”

Jesus did miracles. Jesus showed people His power. Jesus is powerful because He is God’s Son.

**ACTIVITY:** *“make waves” materials:* (sheet from home, balls from bin)

Use a sheet and have the volunteers (and kids ) hold around the sheet, make waves and try to keep the ball inside the sheet. When a lot of waves happen boats can turn over, Jesus spoke to the waves and calmed them. He has power over water and power over evil and He loved his disciples and He loves us.

**ACTIVITY:** *“make a storm” materials:* (none)

While the kids are sitting, make waves like you are sitting on a boat moving side to side, have some of the volunteers make snapping rain sounds, sliding their hands together and blow out through the mouth for wind. In the Bible Jesus rescued his disciples from a storm by telling the storm to be still. Jesus rescues the world by giving His life for us!
