Bible passage: Matthew 9, Mark 5 **Key Passage:** Heb. 1:3

Props: *bring from home: favourite kids book

At centre: activity sheet (2)* in Unit 24.3 & 24.2 PK activity sheets, marker/inkpad

Review Rules:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)

SPEAK KIND WORDS LIKE OUR GOD THREE IN ONE.

INTRO BIBLE STORY: materials: (**favourite kids book brought from home)

This is a story I love and it's all about _____ it has a beginning, a middle and an end. The Bible is one amazing story and its good news! The Good News about what Jesus has done is the Gospel, and it is an amazing story. This story has an amazing beginning (God started it all), and it has an amazing ending (a promise that God will make all the bad things untrue.) Who is the hero in our story? Our hero is Jesus!

We can't see God with our eyes, but we can know what God is like by looking at Jesus, and when we look at the New Testament in the Bible it tells us all about Jesus. **We have learned about God by seeing Jesus calming the storm, feeding over 5000 people from 5 loaves and 2 fishes, showing us God is powerful and loving.**

STORIES OF JESUS: JESUS AND JAIRUS' DAUGHTER

SING A SONG: *He's got the whole world in his hands*

TEACH KEY PASSAGE: "Jesus is the imprint of God's nature" **Hebrews 1:3** (*colour on your finger with marker/use inkpad*) and make an imprint on paper (*in bin*)). Jesus shows us what God is like. Just like this imprint shows us what our fingerprint looks like.

ACTIVITY: "Doctor kit mix up" **materials:** (activity sheet in the folder)

Show the activity sheet to the class and ask for volunteers to come up and point out the things that wouldn't belong in a Doctor's kit (show them the bag on the page and explain that a Doctor's bag is some of the things doctors have in their office, but they put in a bag to visit a patient in the hospital or at home.)

Doctors and nurses and paramedics help heal, but only Jesus can bring life from death. We've learned how Jesus has brought his life to all of the things that represent darkness and disorder, **Chaotic seas**- he stilled them, **broken legs**- made them whole, **evil spirits**- cast them out, and today in our story what did Jesus do? He healed a woman who touched his robe and brought a little girl to life!

ACTIVITY: "No more tears!" **materials:** (activity sheet in folder)

In our Bible Story, the people around the house of the little girl were weeping and crying because they thought she was dead. What does your face look like when you are sad? Can you show me how you cry? We cry when we are sad, and these people were sad, but Jesus said she isn't dead- just sleeping so NO MORE TEARS! The Bible tells us

of a day when there will be a place, a New City we will all live in and it is a NO MORE TEARS place! Won't that be wonderful never to hurt or cry again! This miracle points to that day that will come. What other miracles did Jesus do that point to that, can you draw a line on our activity sheet that points to that day that will come when there will be NO MORE TEARS?

ACTIVITY: *"Sleeping"* **materials:** (none)

Jesus told the little girl to wake up and when he spoke and touched her- his life gave her life. Let's pretend we are sleeping and when I go around and touch you - you are going to get up and jump and say Jesus is our life!

PRAYER: Thank you Jesus for bringing your life to us! Amen
