Key Passage: 2 Timothy 3:16 “All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.”

Props: at home: Quilt or printed pic of a mosaic **Rachel**

At centre: activity sheet and before class write on paper to spread throughout the room. ie. THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD, THE TRUTH ABOUT OURSELVES, THE TRUTH ABOUT OTHERS, THE TRUTH ABOUT THE WORLD

REVIEW RULES:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)

Speak Kind words like our God three in ONE!

INTRO BIBLE STORY: “What is the Bible?”

Rachel

materials: (quilt or printed pic of a mosaic)

Last week we learned that The Bible is a collection of stories that all make up one large story about God’s world and His love for it. We learned:

It’s not like a fiction book which tells a fantastic tale, but it’s not true.

The Bible is telling a story, but it is the truest story ever told, not *just history*, but pointing to TRUTH itself.

It’s not like a “how to Manual” which has detailed instructions for building or fixing things, though the Bible gives us information.

It’s not like a travel book that tells us all sorts of things about places far from here or places from history, though the Bible tells about places and cultures not like ours, it is not a history book, though it speaks about History.

The Bible is a very unique book, it’s the number one selling book of all time, and it’s not like any other. The bible is more than a book. It is God’s wisdom uniquely written to a people that God called and made His own, and we found our story in their story and how God brought salvation to the world through Jesus.

Just like this quilt/mosaic, if we look at one of the pieces of this quilt/mosaic, and decide what the whole thing was through one piece we might think the picture was....(depends on pic) but we need to see the pieces all come together to give us the full picture of the whole.

ACTIVITY:

"The path of wisdom" materials: (before class write on paper to spread throughout the room. ie. THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD, THE TRUTH ABOUT OURSELVES, THE TRUTH ABOUT OTHERS, THE TRUTH ABOUT THE WORLD (Spread out the papers like a path and invite the class to hop from each paper along the path.)

The Bible is not just a book, it's the TRUTH that holds the world together. God wants us to learn His Words in the Bible, so we learn to be wise and follow His path of wisdom which is truth.

ACTIVITY: " pass the Bible" materials: (*Bible, music from your phone*)
