

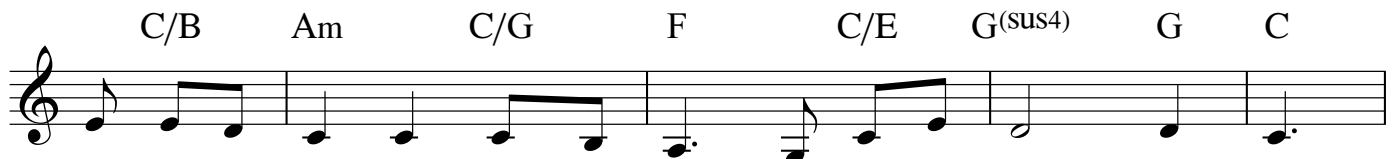

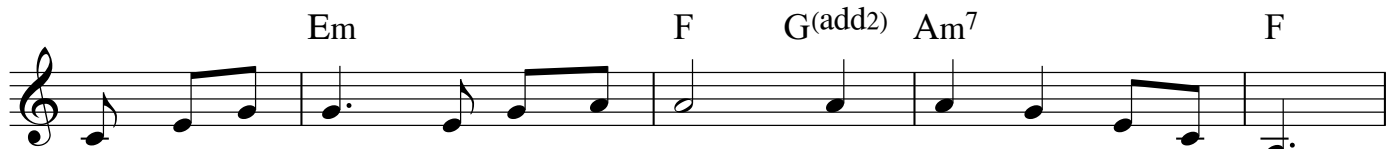

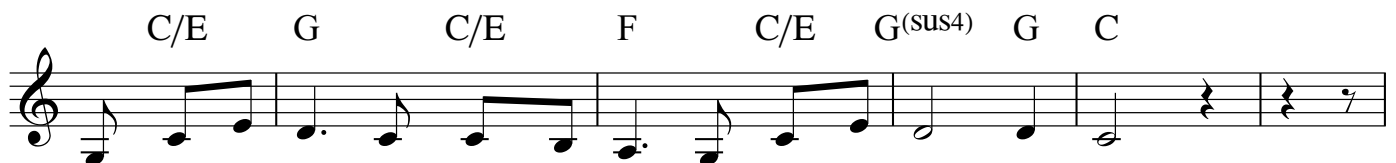
1. When I say that I don't need you; I'll do things my own way,

3. When I'm wronged by those a - round me; When my pa - tience is thin,



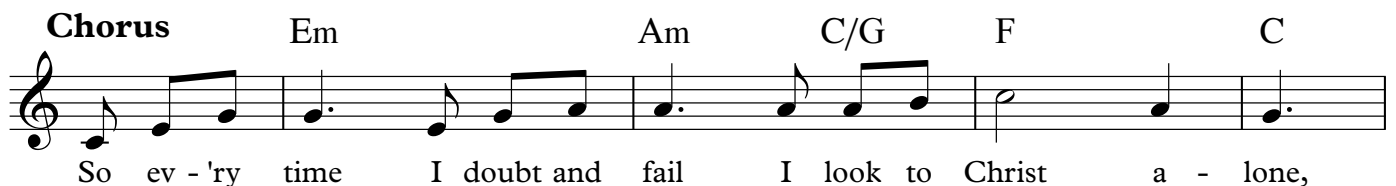
Then be the lan - tern to my feet and guide my steps each day.
