# connections for the Journey

Lenore and I just returned from a trip to Dominica, a small Caribbean island with about 70,000 residents. I did some research. The expected average annual income for 2024, is \$11,000. Needless to say, there is very little tourism and development in Dominica, but it's coming.

I read that not only is it known for being a very friendly island, it is also very safe. We stopped to pick up hitch hikers a variety of times.

One night, Lenore and I were eating at a restaurant, and another English-speaking couple arrived. We hit it off. We talked across the table for the whole meal... actually OUR whole meal. They never received their food after waiting 45 minutes. They told the bartender that they were going to take their meal home instead of eating it there. They then asked us if we wanted to come back to where they were staying. I didn't hesitate. What a great opportunity! When we were leaving, as a joke, I texted my daughters and said that we met these two strangers when we went out to eat, and they asked us to go back to their home with them... if we never see you again, we love you!

Although I DID text that, I DIDN'T have that feeling at all. I felt safe. I felt safe the whole time I was on the island.

Safe spaces allow us to be who we are. Safe spaces allow us to express ourselves. Safe spaces give us the freedom to explore.

Our church will continue to work at being a safe space. It is a never-ending project. It takes all of us to create an atmosphere where people are able to express their beliefs and faith, regardless if it agrees with our own. A safe church space is integral for the development of beliefs.

As a pastor, I don't want you to have my beliefs, nor do I want you to have the Lutheran church's beliefs. I want you to do the difficult work of self-discovery. Hopefully, my beliefs will help you. Hopefully, the beliefs and teachings of the Lutheran church, will help you. Hopefully, you will struggle with the teachings of Jesus on this thing we call "a journey of faith".

Not only did we have a great night with Nate and Raffaella, all four of us created a safe space to talk and discuss... and boy did we ever! I could have stayed all night. But the content of our discussion won't be revealed this Lenten season. You will have to wait till Easter.

# **Cultivating Generosity**

Throughout the fall our congregations are often focused on stewardship and gratitude for the generosity of members. Folks provide stewardship talks, members complete commitment cards, and sermons are proclaimed to encourage generosity of time, talent and finances. But did you know that our ELCA Congregation and Synod Support Team offers training and recommendations on cultivating generosity?

This past fall, in partnership with the Lake Institute on Faith and Giving, stewardship leaders from eight congregations, representing four ELCA synods, came together for a training series called "Cultivating Generous Congregations" (CGC). Over seven weeks leaders from these eight congregations gathered online as a cohort with the Lake Institute's trained faculty and each other. Cultivating Generous Congregations maps the new landscape of religious giving and provides congregational teams with tools to build a culture of generosity unique to each congregation's needs, challenges, and opportunities. CGC explores theology, the role of adaptive leadership, fiscal transparency, and the importance of giver care, with action steps to impact the exploration of generosity and energize congregational generosity to take the significant and necessary steps to creating lasting cultural change.

Following the final session, the eight congregations received a year of access to the Lake Institute's numerous stewardship resources, as well as optional coaching to assist in the implementation of these practices. Mission Support funds the opportunity for congregations and leaders to learn from stewardship experts and one another and to grow together so that their local mission, and how God is growing generosity, can be told in more effective ways in today's culture.
