Developing and investing in leaders are two of my biggest passions in ministry. In Ephesians 4:11-13, Paul writes to the church:

"And he himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, to build up the body of Christ, until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of God's Son, growing into maturity with a stature measured by Christ's fullness" (CSB, emphasis added).

Notice Paul's clear language in the verses above; the pastors of the church are to "equip the *saints*" for ministry. Who are the *saints* to which he is referring? YOU! Part of our shepherding role as pastors is identifying members with leadership potential and investing in them, helping them grow, lead, and minister in the ways God has uniquely gifted them. The result of the saints being identified, equipped, and released for ministry is this: the body of Christ is built up and growing towards maturity in Christ! How awesome that the God of the universe would choose to use broken people like us to lead others to grow in Him.

Here at Temple, one of the most significant ways that the saints lead and disciple the body of Christ is through Sunday School. We have one of the strongest and most consistent Sunday School ministries that I have ever seen! I praise God for that, and I thank the many leaders who have gone before us to make that happen. But **right now, we have a great need for Sunday School leaders and teachers**. Specifically in the Young Adult Ministry, I need *at least* four couples to step up and be willing to lead.
