The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

Every now and then, I read my own Tidings articles . . . many areas. You have walked extra steps (literally!) without again! Maybe I find inspiration? Perhaps, information? Or it might be I forgot what I said and want to reread it! In any case, I stumbled upon an article that I shared at the beginning of 2025. As you might imagine, the subject matter clearly focused on seasons of transition:

For us at Temple, I believe we entering into such a time. As you all know, the next few months will see us spread out all over the campus as significant areas of our building are renovated. We are beginning the Next Chapter together! We are transitioning to another century of God's mission at Temple. And while I believe worship and ministry will continue, I am keenly aware that the temporary displacement and schedule disruption may prompt a measure of anxiety and uncertainty among us. Yet, I have faith that this season will bring blessing. Why such confidence? Because the God Who has worked in us before will do it again! He is the same God! And He is just as powerful as ever!

When I penned those words, we were "entering" a moment of transition—a time of extensive campus renovation. And yes, I expressed great confidence that the Lord would see us through. However, to the gratification of the members, there seemed to prevail a keener sense of dedication to God and loyalty to responsibility on the part of each individual, resulting in a kindred spirit of unity and love beyond expectation. Many comments have been made concerning the closeness felt and the meaningful, worshipful experiences of those days in the Tech building.

Loyalty! Kindred spirit! Love! Closeness! Meaningful! What terms to describe the season! My simple prayer at the beginning of this year was "God, do it again." And my friends, did He ever do it again-and then some! Whether it was the intimacy of smaller gatherings on Sunday mornings or the tremendous crowd for Easter@TheTAC, the Lord has granted us special, powerful opportunities to meet with Him and with our faith family. My prayer is that we recount this season to future generations in the years to come, and hopefully, echo Mrs. Ree's sentiments that it was meaningful and worshipful.




