Case Statement

In 2005, Parkway borrowed \$2.6 million to build a new Children's Building. There was no more adequate space for our children's ministry or our weekday education program, and the church membership desired to provide a safe place to teach children about Jesus.

Times were tight, but the leadership and members believed this was in the best interest of the church and the future growth. Since the dedication of the Children's Building in 2007, literally thousands have come through Parkway's Preschool weekday program. PBC Preschool and Children Ministries have proven time and time again to be invaluable in reaching young families for Christ. We often hear from parents, "Our children brought us back to church." We currently have 165 children enrolled in our Sunday School program with an average attendance of 75.

Plans have been made to pay off the debt on the building as soon as possible, or by 2023 ('Debt Free by 2023'). Your giving to the Faith Campaign will allow the use of more funds to be used for future ministries. Currently, nearly 20% of our general budget is being used to pay off the debt. Now is an exciting time to be a member of Parkway Baptist Church, as we search for the path God will lead!

Consider the following:

- As of September 11, 2019, PBC has a loan balance of \$1,339,665.35
- The loan interest rate is 4.25% for the next five years
- We presently pay approximately \$18,000 from the budgeted general fund every month
- At the present rate we will pay off the loan in 2027

Imagine the following:

- Honor God with a Faith Capital Campaign resulting in \$1.3 million to \$2.6 million given
- PBC would be debt free by April of 2022 (if only \$1.3 million was given)
- God's church would accumulate \$500,000 to \$1.5 million to utilize on future projects
- The church would save \$136,000 of the Lord's money in interest
- \$216,000 currently in our annual budget for debt service could be utilized for more ministry and Kingdom work!

Becoming debt-free will enable our church to redirect those resources to use toward our ultimate goal of leading people to accept Jesus as their personal Savior. The servant leadership of this church is committed to approaching this and any effort from a perspective of Christian stewardship, with a desire for every member to be challenged to grow in discipleship and experience the joy of generosity as we join God in His good work!
