Day 1

John 3:16, For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Thank God for His love and provision.

Day 2

Proverbs 3:5-6, Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Ask God to help you trust Him more.

Day 3

Psalm 37:5, Commit your way to the LORD; trust in Him, and He will act. As you trust God more, ask God to act on our behalf.

Day 4

Proverbs 16:3, *Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established.*Ask God to guide and establish our plans.

Day 5

Philippians 4:6-7, Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Ask God to calm our anxious hearts and to give us His peace as we request His help.

Day 6

James 1:5, If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, Who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

Ask God to give us wisdom regarding our plans.

Day 7

1 John 1:9, If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

 $Confess \ your \ sins, as k for God's \ for giveness, and know \ that \ you \ are \ clean sed.$



John 14:16-17, And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

God has given us the Holy Spirit to guide us. As you pray ask the Holy Spirit to guide our actions and to help us to be faithful in giving to His work.

Day 9

2 Corinthians 9:6-7, The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

Ask God to guide our giving and help us to be a cheerful giver.

Day 10

2 Corinthians 9:10-11, He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God.

Thank God for providing the seed for growth and for multiplying the increase. Ask Him to help us to be generous in giving.

Day 11

Deuteronomy 16:17, Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God that he has given you.

Ask God to help us give in proportion to how He has blessed us.

Day 12

1 Corinthians 15:58, Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

Ask God to help us abound in the work of the Lord.



Day 13

Matthew 6:26, Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?

Ask God to help us not to worry, but to trust in Him for His provision, because He loves us.

Day 14

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, *Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.*

Ask God to help us to rejoice, to pray, and to be thankful in all circumstances, in accordance with His will.

Day 15

Colossians 3:17, And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Ask God to help us do all things in the name of Jesus with thankful hearts.

Day 16

Joshua 1:8-9, This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.

Read God's Word and pray that our actions are consistent with what is written, so that our way will be prosperous and successful in God's eyes. Ask God to be with us, to help us to be strong and courageous, and to keep us from being afraid.

Day 17

Psalm 119:11, I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

Ask God to help us remember His Word and to keep us from sin.



John 14:27, Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

Ask God to give us His peace and to keep us from being troubled and afraid.

Day 19

Isaiah 26:3, You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.

Ask God to fill us with His peace and to help us to trust in Him.

Day 20

Revelation 4:8b, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!

Praise the Lord for His holiness, His presence in our lives, and His future return.

Day 21

Revelation 4:11, Worthy are You, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for You created all things, and by Your will they existed and were created.

Praise the Lord for He is worthy.

Day 22

Jeremiah 29:11, For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Ask God to make His plans clear to us.

Day 23

1 Peter 5:6-7, Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time He may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on Him, because He cares for you.

Humble yourselves before God, and in prayer, give your worries and concerns to Him.



Day 24

Galatians 5:22-23, But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Ask God to fill us with the Holy Spirit and to help us exhibit the fruit of the Spirit.

Day 25

Psalm 118:1, Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; for His steadfast love endures forever!

Thank God for His goodness and His love.

Day 26

Psalm 118:24, This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Praise God and rejoice that He has given us another day.

Day 27

Colossians 3:15, And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

Ask God to fill us with the peace of Christ and to help us be thankful.

Day 28

Matthew 28:18-20, And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Ask God to help us be obedient in fulfilling The Great Commission.

Day 29

Acts 1:8, But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

Ask God to help us be His witnesses in Auburn and around the world.



Psalm 23:1-6, The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Praise and thank God for His guidance, provision, peace, presence, protection, comfort, salvation, and all the many ways He has blessed us.

Day 31

Isaiah 9:6, For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Praise God that He loved us enough to send His Son.

Day 32

Luke 2:10-11, And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."

Praise God for the greatest news ever told: that God loved us enough to send His Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Day 33

Hebrews 11:1-3,6, Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the people of old received their commendation. By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible. And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him. Ask God to strengthen our faith in Him.



Day 34

Romans 1:16-17, For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

Ask God to give us boldness and His power to share the gospel.

Day 35

Psalm 56:3-4, When I am afraid, I put my trust in You. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?

Ask God to strengthen our trust in Him, no matter what others say or do to us.

Day 36

Romans 6:23, For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Praise God for paying the price for our sins and giving us eternal life through Jesus.

Day 37

Romans 5:6-8, For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die — but God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Praise God for loving us enough to die in our place, in order to pay the price for our sins.

Day 38

Romans 12:1-2, I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Pray for God to transform our lives to be holy and to please Him in every way.



Malachi 3:10, Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house. And thereby put Me to the test, says the LORD of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you a blessing until there is no more need.

Ask God to help us be faithful in the privilege of giving and to fully trust in His promises.

Day 40

Revelation 22:20-21, He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.

Ask God to give us a sense of urgency because He is coming soon!!!
