Key Passage: Romans 12:2

### **Checkpoint #3 - Moral Boundaries**

Principle: Purity paves the way to intimacy.

Critical Question: Are your students establishing and maintaining moral boundaries?

Key Passage: 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8

### **Checkpoint #4 - Meaningful Friendships**

Principle: Our friends determine the direction and quality of our lives.

Critical Question: Are students establishing healthy friendships and avoiding unhealthy ones?

Key Passage: Proverbs 13:20

### **Checkpoint #5 - Wise Choices**

Principle: Walk wisely in a fool's world.

Critical Question: Are students making wise decisions?

Key Passage: Ephesians 5:15-17

### **Checkpoint #6 - Ultimate Authority**

Principle: Maximum freedom is found under God's authority.

Critical Question: Are students submitting to the authorities God has placed over them?

Key Passage: Romans 13:1-2

### **Checkpoint #7 - Others First**

Principle: Consider others before yourself.

Critical Question: Do students consider others before themselves?

Key Passage: Philippians 2:3-11

### **9th Grade Phase**

### **11th Grade Phase**

Mobilize their potential by listening, guiding and encouraging their self-expression and then provide an experience to enjoy that expression together (Music, Art, Reading, Nature, Sports, Dance, Space, etc).
