Review It

Read 1 Corinthians 2: 1-5.

In the six weeks leading to Easter, we'll be discussing various attributes of God who became man and dwelt among us in the person of Jesus Christ. Like the Apostle Paul, we'll resolve to know nothing but Jesus—both who He is and what He did for us on the cross, for all eternity.

Talk About It

1. Jesus had described us (the church) as His family, His unified fellowship, His body and His flock. Share examples of how you've experienced Jesus in each of these ways.
2. Take turns reading a verse from Read Psalm 23: 1-6 or read "aloud" together.
3. Have you ever had to quiet a distraught child or anxious loved one, even against their will? What did you do to overcome their resistance --for their own sake, so they could get much-needed peace and rest? Share how Jesus has done the same for you.
4. When we "restore" an electronic device, we wipe out "viruses" and corrupted files and return it to its original factory settings. Equate this with the way Jesus restores our troubled soul.
5. God leads us in the path of righteousness for His name's sake. Have you even traveled a path that does not have His name on it? Describe what it's like to live on the right path.

Act on It As

As Pastor Jared said, green pastures represent the Word of God and still waters represent our times of worship and prayer. When you encounter challenges throughout this week, before worry or frustration overtake you, make a point to turn to God first to be fed by Scripture and refreshed by worship.
