WHO IS THE WINGS PROGRAM INTENDED FOR?

Any child, with developmental or medical disabilities including but not limited to: Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Down Syndrome, Developmental Delay, Muscular Dystrophy, and Cancer.

WHAT DO WE PROVIDE?

We offer a specialized environment for children to experience our children's programming alongside a trained volunteer to work specifically with them. Whether through attending large group programming with an assigned Wings Buddy, or through the use of our Wings sensory room, you can feel confident that your child is in a safe place to learn, explore, and experience God's love.

WHAT IS YOUR SENSORY ROOM?

Our sensory room is a calming space with a variety of resources that provides children with personalized sensory input opportunities to help them calm and focus themselves so they can be better prepared for learning and interacting with others. We understand that at times they may need a break, a quiet place to go, or may work best in a small group environment so we have created a space that will provide:

- sensory and special learning components such as:
 - a weighted blanket, foam pit, interactive/tactile panels, bubble tubes, a noise machine, wave projector, flexible seating options, sensory toys, and modified lighting,
- the opportunity for each child to participate at their level
- modified lessons and activities based on the curriculum

WHAT DO WE NOT PROVIDE?

- Therapy
- Behavioral modification programs (though we will follow through with programs based on parental guidance and tools provided).
- Medical interventions (unless it's an emergency).
- Medical, emotional, social, behavioral, or academic diagnoses

HOW DO I ENROLL MY CHILD?

The first step is to contact our Family Pastor, Julie Spier at juliespier@trinitymesa.church or our Associate Family Pastor, Erika Pfaff at erikapfaff@trinitymesa.church. They will set up an initial interview to meet with you and discuss the needs of your child. It is very important that you contact them prior to your first visit so that the proper arrangements can be made to best support your child.
