DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 4. What part(s) of the Bible do you have the most difficulty believing or sharing with others? What steps can you take this week to understand the passage(s) you question?
- 5. The Bible convicts us when we've done something wrong, it encourages us when we need to be lifted up, and it keeps us anchored in truth when culture is swaying in the wind. How would you describe your current connection with the Bible? Why is it so important to know and understand the Bible? How can you take your understanding to a deeper level this week?
