DISCUSS IT

- 1. Jesus got mad when people were denied access to God. Where do you see that theme in Mark 11, and where might you see it playing out in today's culture?
- 2. When you read the Gospels, do you tend to put yourself on "Jesus' side" in the story? How might it change your spiritual growth to sometimes identify with the Pharisees or the crowd instead?
- 3. How do you evaluate if your preferences are aligned with God's plan? What do you do in the moments that they aren't aligned?

- 4. Jesus used strong words for religious hypocrisy. Why do you think hypocrisy in spiritual leaders or Christians is so damaging to people's access to God?
- 5. In your relationships, how could you shift your goal from "winning an argument" to "winning a heart"?
- 6. "Flip every table in your life that stands in the way of others finding and following Jesus." What "tables" (attitudes, habits, patterns) come to mind for you as you hear that?
- 7. What is one specific area where you sense God inviting you to align your lifestyle more closely with what you say you believe?
