The 2nd phase of following Jesus is getting baptized. Jesus was baptized and Jesus commands us to be baptized. From the beginning of the earliest church to the present, whenever a person makes a decision to trust Jesus, the next step is to make a public declaration of that decision by getting baptized. Baptism is an outward demonstration of an inward transformation.

"Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his."
Romans 6:3-5 (ESV)

Being delivered is the 3rd phase of following Jesus. Deliverance is an ongoing part of the christian life. As we repent of sin, release those who have sinned against us, renounce the lies we've believed, resist the enemy's plans for our lives, and receive the grace Jesus has given us - we get free! Every Christian needs to be delivered. Again and again.

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints." **Ephesians 6:10–18 (ESV)**

The 4th phase of following Jesus is being discipled. A disciple is one person who follows another. Jesus has called us to follow Him and be one of HIS disciples. However, we aren't meant to follow Jesus alone. We are disciples of Jesus in the context of community. Every Christian is called to be a disciple and to make disciples. That means we all need people in our lives pointing us to Jesus, and we are always meant to be pointing individuals in our community to Jesus as well. Discipleship relationships are meant to be forming again and again for as long as we live.

"And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love."
