GLOBAL MISSIONS GOALS

The mission of Christ is plain. "Go to ALL THE WORLD and make disciples of ALL NATIONS." We believe that the gospel is for everyone, regardless of nation, economy, race, or education. Horizon is a sending and supporting church. We believe that it is our calling to go and to provide resources to those who would go for us.

Over 64 Partnering Missionaries | \$163,500

Horizon Community Church partners with over 64 missionaries around the world, including the rest of this list. We are committed to helping those who have received a call from God and are doing great work for Him. These missionaries are the boots on the ground on the front line of the Gospel around the globe. These awesome men and women of God rely on our monthly support as well as funding for special projects and resources.

Convoy of Hope & Disaster Relief | \$55,000

Convoy of Hope is an international relief and aid organization that responds to natural disasters and works to bring hope to the children and families around the world. In addition to disaster relief, Convoy provides ongoing food programs for some of the most impoverished kids in the world, economic empowerment programs for women, education and other resources. convoyofhope.org

Africa's Hope | \$30,000

One of the great moves of God happening right now is through the outreach of Africa's Hope. One of the major problems with the church in Africa for decades now has been that the local pastors are not well trained, equipped or disciplined. Thus, erroneous doctrine and has swept through the churches. Africa's Hope currently has 21,000 pastors in training for certified ministry degrees. We have been given the privilege of partnering with them to build a much-needed college extension in Dire Dawa, Ethiopia.

Remember Nhu: Rescuing Young Women from Sex Trafficking | \$15,000

We have partnered with this great ministry outreach for years, buying land, building homes and securing what is needed to care for these young ladies. What a privilege to be a part of seeing these wonderful young ladies saved, disciplined and receiving career training so they can overcome in life.

Short Term Missions Ventures | \$210,000

These are the trips we take that are 2-3 weeks long with people from our Horizon campuses. Every year our goal is to take 3-4 teams to various locations in the world. This year we are scheduled to be in Ethiopia, Cambodia and one more location to yet be revealed. We believe that when people become short term missionaries like this they are never the same. For the rest of their lives they have the lost and the poor on their hearts and they become people who give, pray and go at a higher level than ever before.

Ministry Care and Special Needs | \$6,000

This is a Wind of the Spirit fund that we keep to help those missionaries and churches when they have an urgent need, such as repairs from a flood or a storm. Also, we help with finishing projects when the cost is too much for our missionaries.

Horizon Missionaries | \$32,400

Horizon Community Church has its own couples that we support as missionaries as well. Remember Nhu in Cambodia, Jerry and Gwen Gibson for Chi Alpha, EPIC in Africa, Tim and Serena Howell with Teen Reach, Garrett and Alissa Larsen with A Jesus Mission, and Pastor Armando and Rosie Juarez to the Spanish speaking community in our local area.

Designated Missions | \$100,000

The Horizon family has a heart for missions. Many who attend our church give over and above the funds that are pledged with contributions designated to specific missionary works. These funds are sent directly to the intended missionary efforts in addition to funds pledged and given through Kingdom Builders.

LOCAL MISSIONS GOALS

Horizon currently spans across five locations in the SW Portland suburbs. Each of these cities has unique needs and challenges that the church is called to face. We are not content to enjoy the blessings God has given us, but instead, we are committed to seeing the hurting, the suffering, and the disenfranchised of our communities know and experience not only the truth of the Gospel, but tangible, real-life expressions of God's love.

Oregon Ministry Network & Assemblies of God | \$40,000

Horizon is part of a great fellowship of missions-minded churches with the Assemblies of God. With over 200 churches in Oregon, 13,000 in the USA, and 370,000 worldwide, the Assemblies of God has a strong missions and ministry impact around the world. Through the tithes of its ministers and designated funds by local churches, the state and national offices oversee local and global ministries that greatly impact the Kingdom.

Campus Fund | \$295,000

Our story teaches us that new ministry adventures present themselves often. The campus fund allows us to launch new campuses like the Coffee Creek Prison site this year. It also allows us to underwrite the campuses we have previously launched until they reach self-sustainability. This fund helps us provide support for streaming and the production to our multi-site campuses and leadership training and central office support.

Community Care | \$15,000

We are committed to loving and serving our cities. Compassion Connect is one way we serve the poor and needy in our area. We join with several other churches in our community to offer medical, dental and eye care through volunteer professionals. We also provide food, clothing and much more through this amazing outreach. Another thing we do is serve and/or adopt public grade schools in our areas. We serve these schools with a free meal for all kids and parents for their back to school night. At some schools we provide reading buddies and recess mentors as well as backpacks full of food for those who are hungry to take home to their families.

Benevolence | \$20,000

People in our church often need help to make it through a hard season in their lives. This fund provides help with food, transportation or bills when people fall on hard times. A part of these funds are designated by families or individuals who want to help out families they know are in need.

Christmas Outreach | \$20,000

Every year we give Christmas gifts and food boxes to the neediest families in our city. Our Horizon families take specific gift requests for the kids and personally buy the items and they also bring thousands of pounds of great quality food for Christmas meal food boxes. Our public schools choose these families who are in need for us and then we fill the requests. We love it!

Project Esperanza | \$12,000

This is an amazing outreach hosted and run by our Horizon Esperanza campus. It is an event where hundreds of Spanish speaking families come and receive new shoes and other gifts. At the end of each session the message of the Gospel is preached with wonderful results.

Approximately 4% of Kingdom Builders income is used for guest speakers, banquets, events, fundraising, promotion, and development for Kingdom Builders.

NEXT GENERATION LEADERS

Horizon believes in supporting the call and investing in the development of the future leaders of the church. We do this by providing scholarships for students who need help paying for summer Bible camps and providing development opportunities for emerging leaders.

Youth Outreach: Jesus Club and Rush | \$10,000

Young people are a priority to us. These two great new outreach programs are focused to reach the lost in our area. We will be starting Jesus Club Bible studies at Tualatin and Sherwood High Schools. Our staff has been trained by the campus ministry organization One Voice and is ready to make an impact this year in our local high schools. Rush is a semi-annual outreach to youth in our area. We will host a huge event night with bands, DJ's and big prizes (donated) and giveaways. These nights will always have a great sermon and call to salvation as the main focus.

Horizon Christian School Designated Scholarships | \$50,000

Children and youth have long been a commitment at Horizon, uniquely evidenced in the ministry of the Learning Center and school that ministers to students and families throughout our communities. The cost of Christian education can be a challenge. The ability to experience ministry and life change at our school would not be possible without the designated contributions we receive from donors who want to make attending Horizon possible for students who otherwise couldn't without this support.

Horizon Worship Influence | \$25,000

God has blessed us with tremendous talent, heart and gifts musically at Horizon. Periodically we do recordings to share with the world the wonderful original worship music that comes out of this house. The last project we did had 3 songs at the top of the independent radio charts, 2 songs hit at #2 and 1 song landed as the #1 song on that chart. One of the songs on the album had nearly 300,000 Spotify listens and found its way to the top of many streaming lists. We feel called to share this great music and become a greater influence for worship in our world. Why not us?

Kids & Youth Camps | \$20,000

These camps provide our kids and teens an exceptional opportunity to get away and experience God. Horizon is committed to helping every young person who wants to attend summer Bible camp get there. This fund provides scholarships and encompasses some cost for leadership and materials to ready the camp and also to keep the cost down for all so more can attend.


