Review this week's message.

Key Scripture: [1 Peter 3:7](#)

Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What incredibly common thing have you never done?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- How would you describe the word, “love?”
- How is marriage a picture of Jesus' relationship to the church?

Start sharing. Ask these questions to create openness.

- What does it mean for the husband to lead his wife? What does it mean for the wife to be a “suitable helper”? (See [Ephesians 5:21-33](#))
- In what ways do you seek God's wisdom in and for your marriage or relationship? How has it influenced the quality of your relationship?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- Take a moment and pray, if you're married, that God would help you to stay committed to Him and your spouse. If you're not married, pray that God would help you to stay solely focused on Him and growing in your relationship with Him.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Take some time this week to find a quiet place where you can tune everything out and have a couple moments with God and be totally fixed on Him.
