WHY GIVE?

God has been generous to us. Not only has he given us all we are and all we have, but God has given us his one and only son. To give sacrificially is to be like him. It is a profound expression of our love for God and neighbours, of faith that God will provide for us, and of hope as we set our hearts on our heavenly inheritance.

God has also given us the privilege of sharing in his great gospel work. Jesus is gathering people into his kingdom. Through our giving we ‘partner’ with others to proclaim Christ and (under God) see people saved and brought to new life.

God has also given us the responsibility of being ‘stewards’ or ‘managers’ of his resources. Jesus calls us to be “shrewd managers”, using our worldly wealth for eternal purposes. We are not to be like the rich fool who stored up wealth for himself, but wasn’t rich towards God. Instead we are to be “generous and willing to share.” Together we also take responsibility to support those whom we have appointed to preach the gospel.

2020 BUDGET

Our church is working hard to pray and proclaim Christ to the people of our area. We currently have 750 ‘members’ of all ages in 6 congregations. Our various ministries have ongoing contact with a further 1000. We also want to see the 18,000 who live around us, connect with Jesus, and we also serve the wider world by sending gospel workers and partnering with missionaries. To do all this we have three separate funds...

1. General Fund

Our Wardens use this fund for the general running of the church. Around 80% pays for our staff. The rest is used for local evangelism, link missionaries, office costs, building maintenance, small property improvements and other running costs.

Taking account of rental and sundry income (from interest etc), we need to raise \$824,000 from regular giving (or \$68,700 per month).

The collections required for 2020 are 8.3% higher than our actual collections in 2019. This will provide for all our ongoing expenses, including our new Belong Ministry Leader, Carolyn Woods..

2. Apprentice Fund

The Jannali Ministry Apprentice Program (JMAP) trains young men and women to leave us to work as pastors, evangelists, church planters, chaplains, etc.

In 2020 Ben Williams is our JMAP Apprentice. The total annual cost to train Ben is \$43,350.

3. Property Fund

This fund is used to invest in facilities for ministry, particularly major capital (building) projects.

We are currently raising funds for our 'Building for Ministry' project. By God's grace we hope to extend and refurbish our building in 2020 or 2021. At the start of 2020 we had \$910,000 in the bank. To reach our fundraising target we require a further \$560,000.

1. By Direct Deposit
