



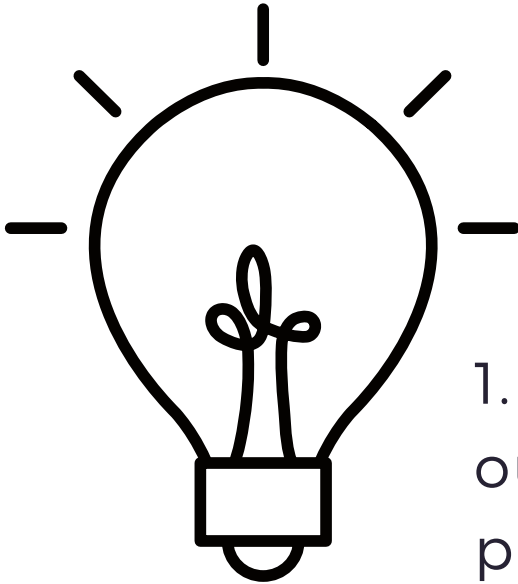


	KEY POINT	BIBLE PASSAGE	PRAYER	QUESTIONS
Day 1	God seeks and saves his lost sheep	LUKE 15:1-7	Pray for those in your life who do not yet know Jesus as their great shepherd and saviour.	<p>NOTE: ASK ALL 4 EVERY DAY:</p> <p> 1. What shines out from the passage?</p>
Day 2	God welcomes back his lost children.	LUKE 15:11-31	Give thanks that God is a welcoming father who treats us like his children when we turn back to him.	<p> 2. What questions do you have about the passage?</p>
Day 3	God's people are wise with the blessings God has given them.	LUKE 16:1-12	Ask God to help seek to use all he has given you for his glory and his Kingdom.	<p> 3. What do you learn about Jesus in this passage?</p>
Day 4	God's people respond rightly to his word about Jesus.	LUKE 16:13-15; 16:19-31	Give thanks that when you heard God's word, you responded rightly to its offer of salvation in Christ.	<p> 4. How can you apply this passage? Is there a sin to avoid, a promise from God, an example to follow or a command to obey or something you need to know? (SPECK)</p>
Day 5	God's people are obedient servants who live by faith	LUKE 17:1-10	Thank God that he can use you for his glory. Pray for opportunities to grow in your trust, obedience and faithful service of him.	

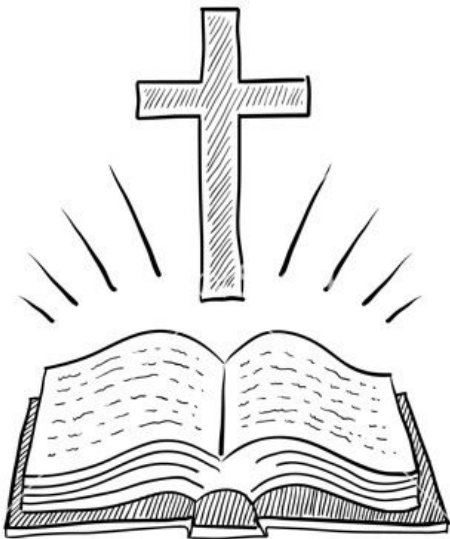
