# THE GREAT SCAPE 08-13.01.2024

This year we'll be introducing a new theme for our Summer Camp. The Great Escape will pitch "inmates" against various challenges as they analyse and plan how to escape from "Chittick Lodge Penitentiary".

# **CHITTICK LODGE**

The Chittick Lodge facility is located in the coastal town of Gerringong, about 1½hrs from Jannali. "Inmates" will be free to enjoy day trips to Werri Beach and other local attractions. The "cell blocks" have en-suite rooms and plenty of space to relax. "Inmates" will enjoy the best penitentiary food served in Australia. (No porridge or stale bread in sight).

#### **BIBLE EXPLORATION**

During the week "inmates" will attend daily chapel where they will explore what the Bible says about the greatest escape of all.

#### THEMED ACTIVITIES

During the week, campers will be placed into "chain gangs" and undertake various tasks that will enable them to have a chance of escaping from Chittick. Skill development might include tunneling, mapping, forged document making, motion sensor evasion, stealth, teamwork and perseverance. You'll want to avoid spending time in "the cooler".

# REGISTRATION

Full registration will be \$460. Subsequent registrations from the same family will each receive a \$50 discount. There is a \$30 Early Bird discount in place until Sunday 19th November. Registrations will close on 24th December 2023. Register at Trybooking.com

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

"Inmates" will travel by secure train from Sutherland Station to Gerringong and then by authorised correctional facility vehicles to Chittick Lodge. (Opal cards will be needed as train fare is not included in registration fee. No Red P plate drivers).

# **YEAR 12 ADVENTURE**

On the last day of camp, our Year 12 students will have a special day trip to Bushrangers Bay where they will get the chance to snorkel over a shark nursery.

# CLARIFICATION

As with all our camp themes, activities and challenges will be by choice. Nobody will be placed in a position where they will be obligated to take part. For those who do take part, we will do everything we can to ensure the experience is both fun and safe.

# INFORMATION

An information letter will be sent out just before Christmas with full details about transport times, medication requirements, overnight screen policy and what to bring to camp.
