COVID SAFETY



- Good hygiene practices will be in place with hand sanitiser available.
- We will be venturing onto public transport on some days and **everyone** will do well to have a face mask with them. The information for each day will indicate when this is the case.

Guidelines for those with symptoms:

INFORMATION FOR DAY 1 – MONDAY 15th JANUARY

There will be a prayer time at 8.00am which youth are welcome to attend.
The program itself begins at 8.30am (please eat breakfast before you come).

Make sure you have the following gear with you:

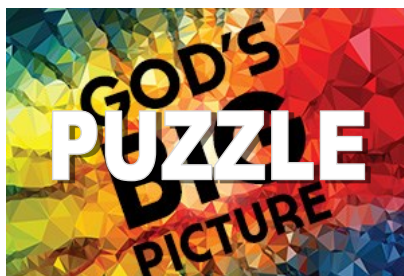
- a clearly labelled water bottle
