Travelling from Sutherland, turn left into the Royal National Park.

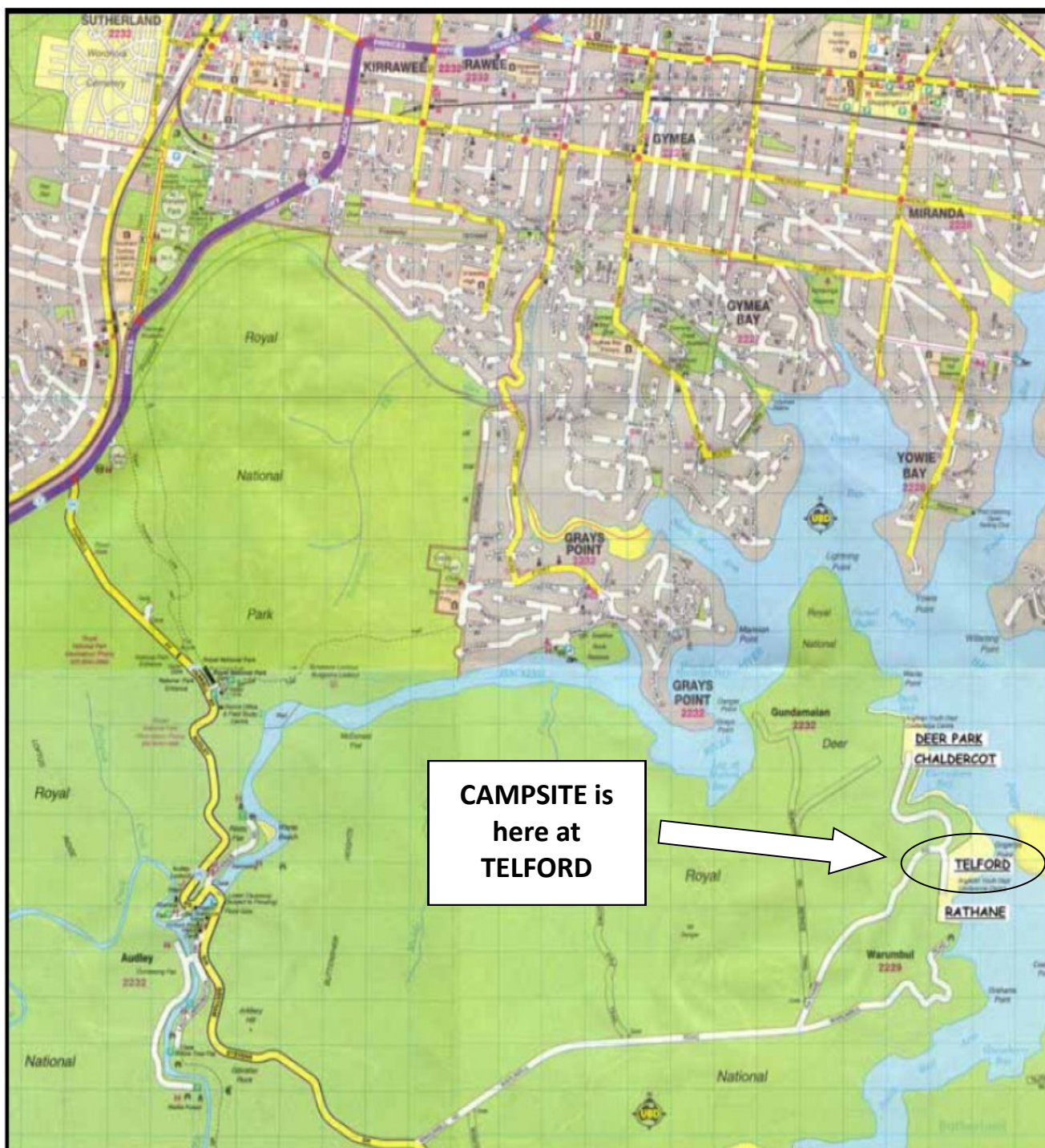
If the Pay Station is attended, just tell them you are going to the Youthworks Campsites.
