We take them to orphanages, the churches, and missions we support, and to the neighborhoods.



ESL Classes

LBCM helps with ESL classes. Being in the border region between two countries means the need to learn both languages, English and Spanish. It is a necessary tool not only for communication, but to improve economic level by making more money. Also, in Universities in the border region of Mexico, English proficiency of at least a 50% level is required for graduation.

Sewing Classes

Sewing Classes are offered to women. These classes are a great way to share fellowship and teach a person a new skill. These women are learning to sew clothing for themselves and their families, make household items, and learn a marketable skill. They also provide opportunities for other ladies from the community to come, learn, and become part of a congregation when there is one close by.
