Thanks to your generosity in April, the cafe raised \$187.43 for CASA.

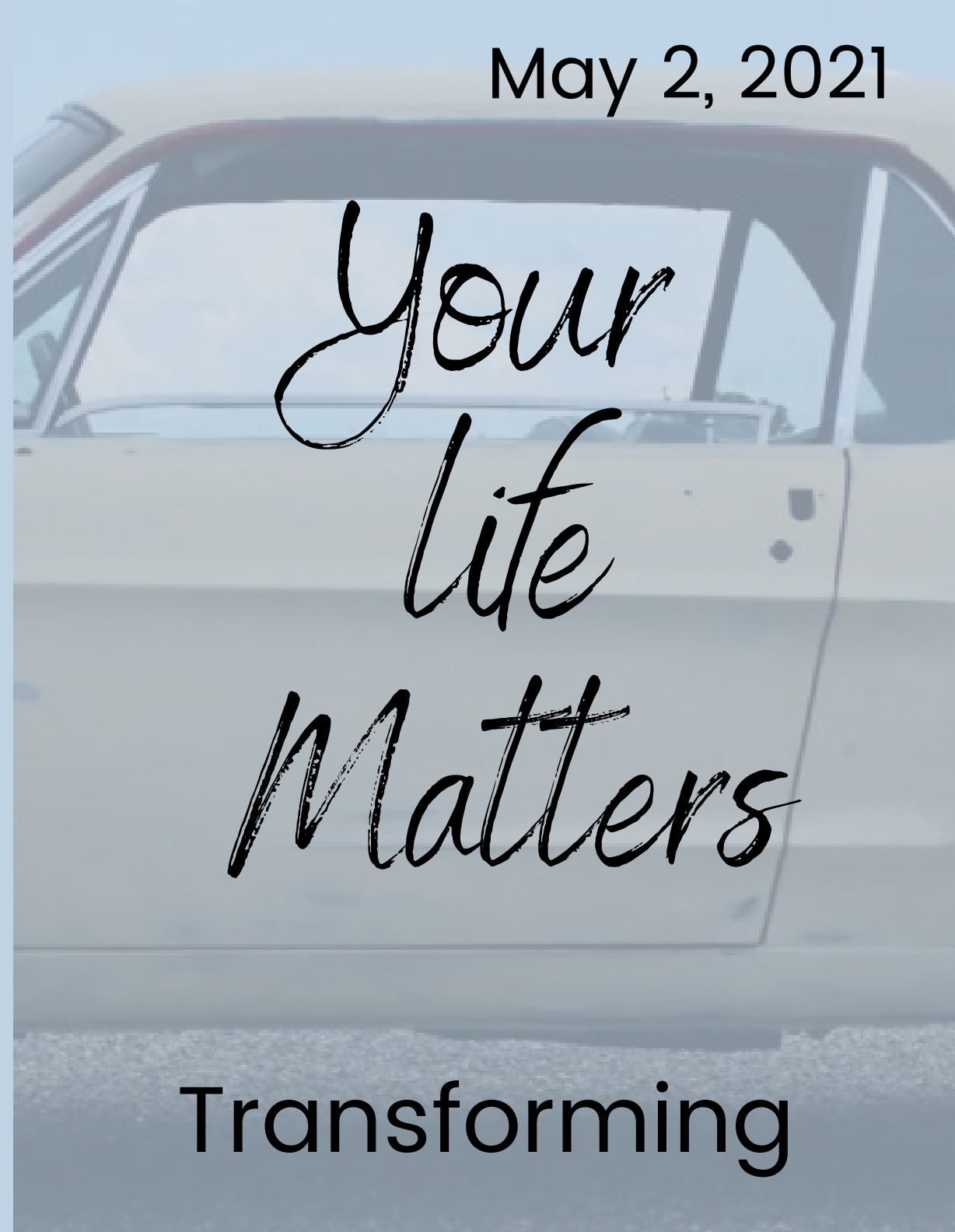
Proceeds for May go to Metroplex Women's Clinic, a free clinic that provides medical services, education, and counseling to women at no cost to them.
