WEEK 2: Who Is God?

MAIN IDEA: God is bigger than any image we have of Him.

We get to know God...

- Through our world
- Through Jesus
- Through scripture

The world was made by God for us. God created us to be in a relationship with Him.

WORSHIP: Sing with the children the song, "God is so good!"

REFLECT: Remind children about our lesson from last week. Ask them about the promises they made since you have seen them.

- Suggestion: If you have more than 3-4 children participating, ask children to turn and talk to someone sitting near them. This strategy allows all children to share their thinking with someone else and saves time. If time allows, ask 1 or 2 children to share their promises with the entire group.

SCRIPTURE: Read Psalm 104:24 aloud with the children.

DISCUSSION: Talk with the children about God's creations.

- God has created so many amazing things. He created all of the birds, bugs, fish and so much more!
- After reading, talk about your favorite God-made creations. Look at God's creations all around you.
- Make a list of everything on Earth God created.

Do you know that everything in creation has a special purpose? It's true! For example, God created a rose to give off a special "rosy" smell just in order to attract insects to fertilize them and make more roses! That's right. He made a flower smell good just so it could help to create more roses!
