



## ***Audio Visual Director Job Description*** **PART-TIME**

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The primary responsibility of the A/V Director is to provide technical expertise and team leadership for the church's sound, media, video, and stage lighting. The A/V Director is also responsible for audio/video technical and creative development, production, and training related to the live/post-production audio/visual needs of MVCC.

The A/V Director ensures that the worship and A/V ministries continue to grow in effectiveness and quality of excellence in alignment with the church's vision, mission, and strategic objectives.

### **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Comfortable and proficient in working with a variety of audio, video, media, and lighting equipment
- Proficient (or willing to become proficient) in ProPresenter, Lightkey, Tricaster, Planning Center, Mac OS, Windows OS, etc.
- Skilled in all levels of video production (pre-production, production, postproduction, camera operation, editing, motion graphics, sound design, color correction, etc.).
- High capacity individual who thrives in a "work hard, play hard" environment and is consistently striving to learn and grow.
- Able to maintain and ensure that all of the AVL equipment is in working order on a weekly basis and be able to troubleshoot as issues should arise.
- Work to train up volunteer AVL coordinators that can be available to serve where needed.

### **SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Mixing quality sound in large venues using digital mixing equipment (Midas M32 and M32R).
- Possess a high level of technical skill and proficiency.
- Be familiar with current technology in lighting, audio, graphics, and video; stay on top of trends in technology.
