Church family,

As we begin to share details about our regathering plan, we can assure you of a several things:

- We are having many strategic meetings about how best to regather.
- Our staff will work tirelessly to ensure a safe, effective regather.
- This document is designed to share an overview of Step One of our plan.
- After Step One, we will continue to increase the footprint of services gradually.

Step One:

- Service Times
 - As we regather, we will have 2 in-person services at 9 and 11 each Sunday morning.
 - Please note the slight change: services will be at 9 and 11.
 - Additionally, we will provide an in-person service each Wednesday night.
- Safety protocols: In Step One, we will practice rigorous safety precautions.
 - We will be utilizing “Enhanced Cleaning Protocols.”
 - Prior to our shut-down, we explained in detail what that means, but we will be re-enacting all of those stringent cleaning guidelines to help keep everyone safe.
 - These protocols call for a deep cleaning prior to Sunday morning and Wednesday evening.
 - It also mandates a continual wiping down of surfaces and cleaning of bathrooms during services, as well as cleaning the worship center in between services.
 - Our plan is to have a completely “touchless service.”
 - As you park your car and enter into our lobbies, the doors will be propped open for your convenience.
 - The doors to the Worship Center will also be propped open.
 - During Step One, we will avoid the usage of bulletins and printed materials.
 - We will ask that you sit as families in a row of your choosing.
 - To meet social distancing guidelines, every other row will be blocked.

- We would encourage you to continue to utilize online giving.
We will provide an offering box of plate in the lobby, if needed.
 - You will quickly notice that all of our staff and volunteers are required to wear a mask for your safety.
 - In Step One, we will not be able to provide nursery or Rkid's services.
We hope to begin adding these in the near future.
 - Life Groups will continue to be online at this time.
- Online Service: we're extremely excited about live, in-person services, but recognize that not everyone will be able to be back yet. Please know that while we ease back into live services, we will continue to provide just as much quality and content online. We know that some shouldn't participate in a live service yet. In fact, we encourage those that are in a higher risk category to continue utilizing the online service.
- Wrap up
 - No doubt, we haven't answered every one of your questions tonight. We will continue to provide more detail and updated information through all communication lines (text, email, social media, and physical mailings).
